RE: Masthead Drain
Windermere "Area A" Reconstruction

Attached are Construction Plans and a 52.0 Petition for the relocation/reconstruction of the Masthead Drain. The relocation/reconstruction is petitioned by the Town of Fishers. The proposed relocation/reconstruction of the Masthead Drain is within existing platted easements of Masthead Sec. 12, Windermere Point Sec. 3 and existing right-ofway of Geist Road.

The relocation/reconstruction is being proposed as part of the Town of Fishers Windermere "Area A" drainage improvements project in the Windermere Point subdivision in Section 9, Township 17 North, Range 5 East, in Fall Creek Township, per plans submitted by the Town of Fishers and their Engineer, GRW Engineers Inc., Dated March 11, 2013, GRW Project No. 4030-04.

The proposed project relocates/reconstructs the portion of the Masthead Sec. 12 Drain between Structures 505-504 and 504-506. The Town of Fishers is proposing to upsize the existing 130 feet of regulated drain between these structures from a 24 inch corregated metal pipe to a 36 inch RCP as part of their Windermere "Area A" drainage improvement project. This portion of regulated drain was outlined in my report dated December 26, 1984 and approved at a hearing on February 11, 1985 (See Hamilton County Drainage Board Minute Book 2, Page 38)

Also, as part of this relocation/reconstruction the Town of Fishers has requested that Hamilton County extend the existing regulated drain from Structure 20731A (Structure 506) Station 1+41 on the west side of Geist Road to Structure 3611A (Station

2+89). The request to extend the regulated drain by the Town of Fishers will add an additional 148 feet of 36 inch RCP drain to the Masthead regulated drain system.

During the preliminary design work for this project the Town's Engineer, GRW Engineers Inc., discovered the existing 24 inch pipe and metal end section on Lot 387 (Jabaai) in Masthead was located outside the platted easement for Masthead Sec. 12 (See Hamilton County Recorder's Office, Plat Cabinet 1, Slide 116). In order for the proposed new 36 inch pipe to remain where the existing pipe exists today the Town of Fishers and GRW was able to obtain an additional 5 feet of permanent easement from Lawrence D. & Loretta N. Jabaai on Parcel Number 13-15-09-02-01-043.000.

The remaining relocation/reconstruction will be in existing platted easement and right-of-way including the new drain between Stations 1+41 and 2+89 on the west side of Geist Road which is located within a platted 20 feet Drainage Easement within the Windermere Point Subdivision on the Fritts, David A. and Winebrenner, Matthew J. & Maya K. properties. The proposed relocation/reconstruction will add additional regulated drain easement to the following lots in Windermere Point Sec.3.

19-15-09-00-16-016.000 19-15-09-00-16-015.000 Windermere Point Sec. 3, Lot 44 Windermere Point Sec. 3, Lot 45

I recommend the Jabaai Easement Document for the additional 5 feet of permanent easement on Lot 387 (Jabaai) in Masthead Sec. 12 be accepted by the Board at this time.

The cost of the relocation/reconstruction is to be paid by the Town of Fishers. Therefore, a performance bond is not required for the relocation/reconstruction.

I recommend that the Board set a hearing for this relocation/reconstruction for June 24, 2013.

FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the **Masthead Drain**, **Windermere "Area A" Reconstruction** came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing on June 24', 2013, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the ${\it Masthead\ Drain}$, ${\it Windermere\ "Area\ A"\ Reconstruction}$ be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:


The Board issued an order declaring the proposed improvement established. Such findings and order were marked filed and are available for inspection in the Office of the Hamilton County Surveyor.






WINDERMERE "AREA A" STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS

















PLAN SET IS FULL SCALE ON 24"X36" AND HALF SCALE ON 12"X18"

GENERAL NOTES:

- IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO AVOID EXISTING UTILITIES AND PERFORM ANY REQUIRED REPAIRS. HE SHALL ALSO BE RESPONSIBLE TO CONTACT ANY UTILITY OWNER AS NECESSARY TO RESOLVE ALL UTILITY CONFLICTS INCURRED DURING THE COMPLETION OF HIS CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS
- ALL TREES AND SHRUBS IN THE VICINITY OF THE PROPOSED SEWER SHALL BE PROTECTED. NO TREES OR SHRUBS SHALL BE REMOVED WITHOUT APPROVAL FROM THE OWNER OR ENGINEER'S REPRESENTATIVE.
- 5. ALL DISTURBED GRASS AREAS SHALL BE RESTORED WITH TOPSOIL, SEED MIX AND STRAW AS PER SPECIFICATIONS SECTION 02920 UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL DISTURBED AREAS SHALL BE RESTORED TO EQUAL TO OR BETTER THAN ORIGINAL CONDITIONS. CROSSINGS SHALL MAINTAIN A MINIMUM OF 18" VERTICAL CLEARANCE FROM SANITARY SEWER AND WATER LINE CROSSING. WHERE 18" VERTICAL CLEARANCE CANNOT BE MAINTAINED, CONTRACTOR SHALL SET CONCRETE CRADLES AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE OWNER.
- 19. CONTRACTOR SHALL ENSURE POSITIVE DRAINAGE TO INLETS FOR ALL DISTURBED AREAS.
- 20. PIPE APPURTENANCES ARE NOT SPECIFICALLY CALLED OUT ON THE PLANS. THE CONTRACTOR'S BID SHALL INCLUDE ALL APPURTENANCES NECESSARY FOR

- 22. CONTRACTOR SHALL EXCAVATE ALL EXISTING STORM SEWER AT PROPOSED CONNECTION POINTS TO VERIFY LOCATION, DEPTH AND SIZE PRIOR TO ANY CONSTRUCTION INCLUDING MATERIAL ORDERS. ENGINEER SHALL BE NOTIFIED IN WRITING OF ANY DISCREPANCIES FOUND THAT WOULD IMPAIR CONTRACTOR'S ABILITY TO INSTALL STORM SEWER AS SHOWN IN PLANS.

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









PROFILE - STA. 0+00 TO STA. 0+54 LINE "C"



Please regard this as the Inspector's Final Report on the Masthead Drain, Windermere "Area A" Reconstruction, located in Section 9, Township 17 North, Range 4 East in Fall Creek Township, Hamilton County, Indiana. This was a drainage reconstruction project completed by the Town of Fishers.

The Drainage Board on August 13, 2012 approved paying \$34,898.00 for upsizing of the Masthead Drain with the Windermere Area A reconstruction by the Town of Fishers. The \$34,898.00 amount was based on a preliminary Engineer's estimate from the Towns engineer, GRW, for the upsizing of One Hundred Ten (110') feet of existing Masthead regulated drain. (HCDB Minute Book 14, Page 233)

At the June 24, 2013 meeting of the Hamilton County Drainage Board the hearing for the Masthead Drain, Windermere "Area A" Reconstruction was held, the Surveyor's Report dated April 16, 2013 was approved and the Finding and Order signed. As part of the hearing the Town of Fishers requested the regulated drain be extended between structure 20731A (Structure 506) Station 1+41 on the west side of Geist Road to structure 3611A (Station 2+89) The request to extend the drain by the Town added an additional 148 feet of 36" RCP pipe to the Masthead regulated drain system. (HCDB Minute Book 15, Pages 48-50).

The engineer's estimate for the entire project was \$226,500.00. The bid for the reconstruction was awarded on September 3, 2013 to Calumet Civil Contractors by the Town of Fishers for the amount of \$156,000.00.

The County Surveyor's Office on September 3, 2014 received a new invoice from the Town of Fishers in the amount of \$47,890.21. The new invoice had an additional \$12,992.21 for the

upsizing and extension approved by the Board at hearing of the Masthead Drain for the Windermere Area "A" Reconstruction.

The total construction cost for the Masthead Drain, Area A Reconstruction was \$156,910.86. The Town of Fishers portion was \$109,019.95 (69%) and the County's portion was \$47,890.91 (31%).

The Board's at its meeting on October 13, 2014 voted to pay the extra \$12,992.21. (HCDB Minute Book 15, Pages as yet to be assigned)

A claim in the amount of \$47,890.91 will be submitted to the Hamilton County Auditor on October 24, 2014 for payment of the County's portion of the project. The check will be mailed to the Town of Fishers on November 12, 2014.

As of the date of this report, I hereby attest to and agree that the reconstruction was completed according to the specified plans and have approved such work under IC-36-9-27-82(a). All inspections have been completed and red line drawings were completed and submitted by the Town of Fishers Engineer, GRW.

I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.
