TO: Hamilton County Drainage Board

RE: Amos Underwood Drain

At the meeting of July 27, 2015 the Board moved to remove the assessment for the Mathews & Underwood Drain from the tract 01-01-07-00-00-012.000 owned by Beck Family Limited Partnership. A portion of the Amos Underwood Drain, which is an arm to the Mathews & Underwood Drain, begins on this tract and runs north. The drain begins approximately 280 feet east of the Hamilton-Boone County Road and approximately 400 feet south of the northwest corner of the above mentioned tract. The length of drain across this tract is approximately 488 feet.

Because this portion of drain does not cross or serve a county road for drainage and, per testimony by a representative of Beck's at the meeting of the 27<sup>th</sup>, the tile will be replaced with new tile draining south to the Thomas Pierce Drain along with a surface waterway to be installed running south. I recommend this portion of tile be vacated. The vacation would involve all portions of the drain south of the north line of tract 01-01-07-00-00-012.000.

I recommend the Board set this for hearing for September 28, 2015.

The Board now finds that the costs of continued maintenance to the portion of the above drain exceed the benefits to the real estate benefited by the portion of the drain to be abandoned and issues this order vacating the above section of the Amos Underwood Drain, Station 0+00 to Station 4+90.

The Board will consider whether the drain performs the function for which it was designed and constructed; whether the expense of maintenance outweighs the benefits to be derived therefrom, and whether the abandonment thereof will not be detrimental to the public welfare.
