RE: Mathews & Underwood Drainage Shed

Attached is a drainage map, drainage shed map and assessment roll for the Mathews & Underwood Drainage Shed. This shed consists of the Lycurgus Mathews and Amos Underwood Drains, located in Sections 5,6 7 T 20 R 3E in Adams Township.

The Mathews Drain was originally a tile-William McMath Drain and later the Leander Boyer Drain. In 1913 it was reconstructed as the Lycurgus Mathews Drain, consisting of 10,850 feet of open-Drain within Hamilton County.

The Amos Underwood Drain was constructed in 1891. In 1907 it was reconstructed as the Ted McKinney Drain at which time the remaining open ditch was tiled. The Underwood Drain consists of 15,055 feet of tile drain.

In 1967 the Mathews Drain in Clinton County was placed on Maintenance.

This included a portion in Hamilton County. In June of this year, 1983,
the maintenance between the Counties was separated and each county is to
assess and maintain its own portion of the Mathews.

I recommend that both the Lycurgus Mathews and Amos Underwood Drains be combined into one drainage shed under maintenance. With 1,320.56 acres in the shed at \$2.00 acre, \$6.00 minimum the yearly assessment will be \$2666.00.

I suggest a hearing be set for 1:30pm November 7, 1983.
