On May 5, 1980 at its regular meeting the Hamilton County Drainage Board received a petition for the addition of an Arm to the E.O. Michaels Drain. The proposed Arm is an existing tile which is described as follows:

The tile drain begins approximately 1000 feet East of the North West corner of the South East quarter of Section 25, Township 19, North, Range 5 East. The tile then runs in a South Westerly direction, crossing under Durbin Road about 900 feet South of the above mentioned corner and outleting into the open portion of the Michaels Drain approximately 1200 feet West and 1400 feet South of said corner. This drain consists of approximately 2700 feet of 8 inch tile.

The proposed Arm will not increase the Drainage Shed of the Drain. Also the yearly amount of the assessments will not change.

The Board has set a hearing date for August 4, 1980 at 2:00 P.M. in the Commissioners Court Room, 3rd floor, Courthouse, Noblesville, Indiana.

Any landowner in the Drainage Shed of the Michaels Drain who objects to the proposed addition of the above Arm must submit their objection in writing 5 days before the scheduled hearing date.
