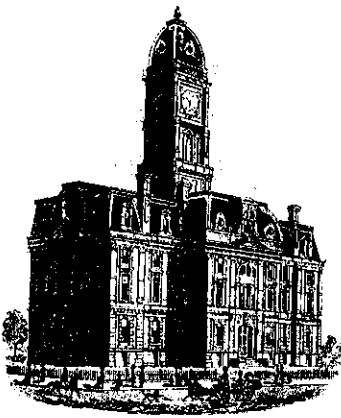

Attached is a petition, non-enforcement request, plans, calculations, Quantity summary and assessment roll for the Mill Creek Drain, Section 9.

I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefitted. The drain will consist of the following:



The total length of the drain will be <sup>2010'</sup>~~1992~~ feet.

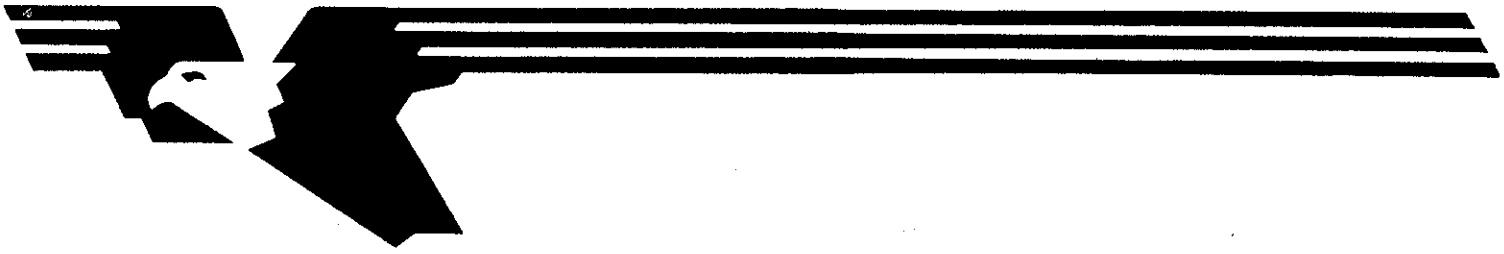
I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$25.00 per lot, \$2.00 per acre for roadways. With this assessment the total annual assessment for drain/this section will be \$233.28.

I recommend a hearing be set for August 1987.


RE: Mill Creek Drain Section 9

I have inspected the drainage facilities for the Mill Creek Drain, Section 9 and have found them to be complete and acceptable. The Project Engineer has submitted the Certificate of Completion and Compliance and "As Built" Drawings on reproducible mylar of the drainage system.

During the construction of this section there were no changes to the original plan. The length of the drain remains at 1992 feet.

Upon looking at the report dated June 5, 1987 and the plan I believe that clarification should be made on the 24" RCP under the street between Lots 70 and 71. This pipe is not included with the total footage for the drain in this section and will be installed and included with the development, South of these lots.

At this time I recommend the Board approve the drainage facilities as constructed. I further recommend that the non-enforcement request for this plat be approved by the Board.
