Attached is a petition and plans for the proposed relocation of the Orville Keys Arm drain. This drain is located in Washington Township. The relocation is being proposed by Eaton Investments. The proposal is to reconstruct the Orville Keys Drain along the west right of way for Gray Road from Sta. 27 + 70 of the U.G. Mitchner Drain to Sta. 10 of the Orville Keys Drain, Arm 2.

The new drain shall consist of those lengths of pipe between the following structures as shown on plans by Cripe Engineering date March 9, 2004, project Number 980516-20500 and on plans for Section 1 and 2 of Bridgewater dated August 13, 2003: Structure 7401 to 7402, 7403, 7403A, 7404, 7405, 7406, 7407, 7408, 7409, 7410, 7411, 7412, 7413, 7414, and 7485. Also to be included is the portions of pipe between Structures 7412, 7415, 7416, 7417, 7418, 7419, and 7420 along with the pipe section between Structures 7403A and 7403B and Structure 7408, 7433, and 7444.

- 2. IN ADDITION, EXCAVATIONS EXCEEDING TWENTY (20) FEET IN DEPTH REQUIRE THE DESIGN OF A
- TRENCH SAFETY SYSTEM BY A REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER.
- ALL STRUCTURES SHALL HAVE CASTINGS, JOINTS, LIFT RINGS, STEPS AND PIPE CONNECTIONS WELL GROUTED, TROWELED SMOOTH AND BRUSH FINISHED.
- 4. ALL STRUCTURES (IE: MANHOLES, INLETS) SHALL HAVE POURED FLOW LINES AND BENCH WALLS. THE FLOW LINES AND BENCHWALLS SHALL BE TROWELED SMOOTH AND BRUSH FINISHED.
- 5. FIELD ADJUSTMENTS OF TOP OF CASTING (T.C.) OF STRUCTURES MAY BE REQUIRED TO MEET FIELD CONDITIONS. ADJUSTMENTS EXCEEDING FIVE TENTHS (0.5) OF A FOOT MUST BE APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER TO DETERMINE THE INTEGRITY OF THE STRUCTURE AT NO COST TO THE OWNER.

- 8. FULL DEPTH GRANULAR BACKFILL SHALL BE REQUIRED UNDER AND WITHIN (5) FEET OF ALL PAVED AREAS, INCLUDING CURBS, EDGE OF PAVEMENT, AND SIDEWALKS.
- 9. PIPES LENGTHS ARE MEASURED FROM CENTER OF STRUCTURE TO CENTER OF STRUCTURE AND INCLUDE END SECTIONS.
- 10. ALL CURB UNDERDRAINS SHALL BE CONNECTED TO THE STORM COLLECTION SYSTEM AT

EITHER AN INLET OR A MANHOLE.

11. ALL EXISTING PRIVATE OFF-SITE DRAIN TILES, ENCOUNTERED DURING CONSTRUCTION, SHALL BE TIED INTO THE PROPOSED STORM SEWER SYSTEM WITH A POSITIVE OUTFLOW.









