Re: Moffitt Williamson Drain – Martin Marietta Materials Relocation

Attached are petitions and plans for the proposed relocation of the Moffitt Williamson Drain, Asa Williamson Arm and Asa Williamson Extension Arm. The relocation is being proposed by Martin Marietta Materials, Inc. Petitions for Relocation and Reconstruction have been submitted by Martin Marietta Materials, the parent company of American Aggregates Corporation that owns parcel 17-14-09-00-002.000, and E. & H. Mueller Development, LLC, which owns parcel 17-14-09-00-00-003.000. The proposal is to relocate the existing Moffitt Williamson open drain from Sta. 56+31 to Sta. 84+63 so that it is out of the way of the proposed mining operation that will expand onto these parcels.

The relocated drain shall consist of 4,110 feet of open drain from Sta. 56+31 to Sta. 84+63. The open ditch is as shown on the construction plans prepared by Weihe Engineers, having job number W00-0285, original date of November 10, 2000, and stamp approved by HCSO on December 9, 2008.

The drain in total will consist of the following lengths:

4,110 feet of open ditch

The total length of new drain shall be 4,110 feet. The 2,832 feet of the original Moffitt Williamson Drain, including 2,444 feet of the Moffitt Williamson Drain, Asa Williamson Arm from Sta. 56+31 to Sta. 80+75 per the original 1951 legal description, and 388 feet of the Moffitt Williamson Drain, Asa Williamson Extension Arm from Str. 80+75 to Sta. 84+63 per the original 1983 legal description, shall be vacated. This proposal will add an additional 1,278 feet to the Moffitt Williamson Drain.

The cost of the relocation is to be paid by Martin Marietta Materials, Inc.

It is proposed that the maintenance of the 4110 feet of the relocated Moffitt Williamson Drain between the original Sta. 56+31 and original Sta. 84+63 will be the responsibility of Martin Marietta Materials, Inc. A formal agreement will be presented to the Hamilton County Drainage Board in the future for approval and then recorded in the office of the Hamilton County Recorder. At this time the agreement is being reviewed by the Board's attorney.

The petitioner has provided the Performance Bond as follows:

In addition to the easement on the parcels this project in within, new easement will be placed on parcel 17-14-09-00-001.000, which is owned by American Aggregates Corporation.

The easements for the drain will be the statutory 75' easement from the top of bank of the drain. Attached are two requests for non-enforcements of easement for encroachment of the mining operations within 30 feet of the top of bank. The Board approved these requests with the approval of this petition for relocation.

I recommend the Board set this item for hearing for April 27, 2009.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the Moffitt Williamson Drain, Martin Marietta Materials Relocation be and is hereby declared established.

## MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT entered into this day of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, 2009, by and between MARTIN MATERIALS, INC., of Wake County, State of North Carolina, hereinafter referred to as "Martin Marietta"; and the HAMILTON COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD, of Hamilton County, State of Indiana, hereinafter referred to as "Drainage Board".

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Martin Marietta operates a sand and gravel plant, limestone quarry and underground mine in Clay Township, Hamilton County, State of Indiana and desires to expand the existing operation;

WHEREAS, Martin Marietta intends to relocate approximately 2650 feet of the existing Moffitt & Williamson Drain (also known as "Blue Woods Creek"), south of 106<sup>th</sup> Street, west of Hazel Dell Parkway and east of Gray Road, generally as depicted and described in Exhibit A attached hereto, in Clay Township, Hamilton County, State of Indiana, and has received approval for the relocation from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management and the Indiana Department of Natural Resources (the "Relocated Segment");

WHEREAS, the Relocated Segment is within property owned by Martin Marietta, Parcel No. 17-14-09-00-002.00 located at 0 River Avenue and within property leased by Martin Marietta and owned by E. & H. Mueller Development, LLC, Parcel No. 17-14-09-00-003.00 located at 5345 East 106<sup>th</sup> Street (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Property"):

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2009, the Drainage Board, authorized Martin Marietta to maintain and reconstruct the Relocated Segment. The approval of the Drainage Board to relocate the above described Relocated Segment was subject to Martin Marietta accepting the responsibility to maintain the Relocated Segment;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 paid by Martin Marietta to Hamilton County Drainage Board, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, and such further considerations as herein mentioned, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by this reference as if fully restated herein.
- Martin Marietta shall reconstruct and maintain the Relocated Segment. Maintenance shall consist of removal of obstructions to flow, stabilizing stream banks that are eroding, removal of woody growth within the stream, removal of beaver dams and annual mowing of the easement area of the Moffitt & Williamson Drain across the Property to the extent allowed by applicable laws and regulations. The existing tree rows west and south of the Relocated Segment are not to be removed. These rows start at the beginning of the Relocated Segment at Station 41+10 and

extend to a point approximately 100 feet west of River Road at approximate Station 14+40.

- 3. Martin Marietta will maintain the Relocated Segment of the Moffitt & Williamson Drain across the Property in accordance with the standards set forth in Ordinance No. 4-26-99-C and in accordance with any other applicable legal requirements.
- 4. <u>Inspections.</u> The Hamilton County Surveyor of his representative (the "Surveyor") shall have the right to inspect the Relocated Segment. The Surveyor shall contact the Martin Marietta North Indianapolis Plant Manager or his representative at (317) 846-5942 at no less than 48 hours prior to entering the site to assure that he is aware of the safety concerns associated with the nearby mining activities.
- Termination. Martin Marietta's obligations under this Maintenance Agreement will continue until Martin Marietta ceases its surface mining operations on and completes reclamation on Parcel No. 17-14-09-00-00-003.00 owned by E. & H. Mueller Development, LLC, and provides notice thereof to the Drainage Board. In the event of and upon the date that the Drainage Board resumes maintenance jurisdiction over that part of the Moffitt & Williamson Drain that is the subject of this Agreement, then this Agreement shall terminate and have no further force or effect, and Martin Marietta shall have no further responsibilities or obligations under this Agreement regarding the maintenance of the subject drain, as long as the Relocated Segment is in the condition of maintenance required in Section 3 above at the time notice is given to the Drainage Board.
- 6. Notices. Any notice or other communication provided for hereunder will be in writing and may be (i) served by personal delivery, (ii) made by facsimile transmission, or (iii) sent by overnight courier service (with all fees prepaid) to the receiving parties as follows, or to any other address which either party may hereafter designate for itself in writing:

Any such notice or communication shall be deemed to be given, if delivered in person, on the date delivered, if made by facsimile transmission, on the date transmitted, or, if sent by overnight courier service, on the date sent as evidenced by the bill of lading, and shall be deemed received, if delivered in person, on the date of personal delivery, if made by facsimile transmission, upon confirmation of receipt (including electronic confirmation), or if sent by overnight courier, on the first business day after the day sent.

- Assignment; Binding Effect. This Agreement shall be binding upon the parties to this Agreement and their respective legal representatives, heirs, devisees, legatees, or other successors and assigns, and shall inure to the benefit of the parties to this Agreement and their respective permitted legal representatives, heirs, devisees, legatees, or other permitted successors and assigns.
- 8. <u>Interpretation: Captions.</u> Whenever the context so requires, the singular number shall include the plural and the plural shall include the singular, and the gender of any pronoun shall include the other genders. Titles and captions of or in this Agreement are inserted only as a matter of convenience and for reference and in no way affect the scope for this Agreement or the intent of its provisions.
- 9. <u>Entire Agreement.</u> This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties to this Agreement with respect to its subject matter, supersedes all prior agreements, if any, of the parties to this Agreement with respect to its subject matter, and may not be amended except in writing signed by the party to this Agreement against whom the change is being asserted.
- No Waiver. The failure of any party to this Agreement at any time or times to require the performance of any provisions of this Agreement shall in no manner affect the right to enforce the same; and no waiver by any party to this Agreement of any provision (or of a breach of any provision) of this Agreement, whether by conduct or otherwise, in any one or more instances, shall be deemed or construed either as a further or continuing waiver of any such provision or breach or as a waiver of any other provision (or of a breach of any other provision) of this Agreement.
- 11. <u>Governing Law.</u> This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Indiana, without regard to principles of conflict or choice of law.

12. <u>Counterparts.</u> This Agreement may be executed in two or more copies, each of which shall be deemed an original, and it shall not be necessary in making proof of this Agreement or its terms to produce or account for more than one of such copies.

During construction, changes there were no significant changes made to the drainage plans submitted with my report for this drain dated February 3, 2009. 

# CONSTRUCTION PLANS FOR RELOCATION OF BLUE WOODS CREEK HAMILTON COUNTY, INDIANA



## General Note

THE WORK COVERED BY THIS SPECIFICATION CONSISTS OF FURNISHING ALL LABOR AND EQUIPMENT AND PERFORMING ALL OTHER OPERATIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROPOSE CHANNEL AND BANKS. WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED BETWEEN STATIONING 0+00 AND 41+10.00 OR .78 MILES.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH CONTRACTOR TO VERIFY ALL EXISTING UTILITIES AND CONDITIONS PERTAINING TO HIS PHASE OF THE WORK. IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTORS RESPONSIBILITY TO CONTACT THE OWNERS OF THE VARIOUS UTILITIES BEFORE WORK IS STARTED. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY IN WRITING THE OWNERS OR THE ENGINEER OF ANY CHANGES, ERRORS OR OMISSIONS FOUND ON THESE PLANS OR IN THE FIELD BEFORE WORK IS STARTED OR RESUMED.

STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS OF THE HAMILTON COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE SHALL APPLY FOR ALL WORLAND MATERIAL.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING ALL STATE, CITY AND COUNTY PERMITS.

CONTRACTOR SHALL CHECK WITH THE ENGINEER PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION TO VERIFY DATE OF PLANS.

ALL CONTRACTORS SHALL VERIFY SUBSURFACE CONDITIONS PRIOR TO BIDDING.

UNDERGROUND TILES NOT VISIBLE ON THE SURFACE MAY EXIST. ANY TILES ENCOUNTERED DURING CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE MAINTAINED WITH POSITIVE DRAINAGE.

A TEMPORARY SEEDING MIXTURE IN THE AREAS WHERE STRIPPING OF FILLS HAVE BEEN GRADED, SHALL BE SEEDED FOR SILT AND EROSION PROTECTION. AFTER GRADING, ALL CONSTRUCTION AREAS ARE TO BE SEEDED AS FOLLOWS:

A. SWALE SEEDING: SEED AND FERTILIZE WITHIN CONSTRUCTION LIMITS WITH 5#/ACRE "REDTOP"

CRASS 20#/ACRE "RYE CRASS" 20#/ACRE "BLUECRASS" 25#/ACRE "FESCUE" AND 600#/ACRE

GRASS, 20#/ACRE "RYE GRASS," 20#/ACRE "BLUEGRASS," 25#/ACRE "FESCUE" AND 600#/ACRE 12-12-12 FERTILIZER.
