

Attached is a petition, non-enforcement request, plans, calculations, quantity summary and assessment roll for the Lexington Farms Arm, Section 7 to the Richard Moffitt Drain. I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages, and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefitted. The drain will consist of the following:

6"	SSD	320	Ft.
12"	RCP	74	Ft.
15"	RCP	40	Ft.

The total length of the drain will be 484 Feet. 434

Only the main Subsurface Drains (SSD) will be maintained as part of the regulated drain. The branches or caterals for each lot will not be maintained as part of the drain. As set out in my report dated October 20, 1989 for Section 3, the SSD in the rear of lots 149 to 152 will not be part of the regulated drain, since storm sewer access is available.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$30.00 per lot, \$5.00 per acre for roadways, with a \$30.00 minimum. With this assessment, the total annual assessment for the drain/this section will be

## \$\_420,00\_\_\_\_\_.

Further, the parent parcel of this system is presently assessed to the Home Place Drain. Lots 140, 141, 142, 143, 144, 145, and 146 will drain into both the Richard Moffitt and the Home Place Drains. Therefore, these lots should be assessed to both drains.

I recommend a hearing be set for October, 1990. At that time, I recommend the Board approve the non-enforcement of easement request for this section.
