Re: Morrow-Follett Drain, Donahue Arm, 1st on Main Partial Abandonment

Attached is a petition to abandon a portion of the Morrow-Follett Drain, Donahue Arm by the City of Carmel and Lauth Group, Inc. The proposal is to abandon a portion of the existing drain on parcels 16-10-30-09-05-001.000, 16-10-30-09-05-025.000, 16-10-30-09-05-024.000, 16-10-30-09-05-022.000 owned by The City of Carmel Redevelopment Commission.

The portion of the Donahue Arm of the Morrow-Follett drain to be abandoned will begin on the south side of E. Main Street in downtown Carmel at Sta. 0+0 per the drains 1950 description and run north for 38 feet before stopping at a structure on the north side of E Main Street at Sta. 0+38 per the drains 1950 description. The drain then runs north for 280 feet before stopping on the south side of 1st St N.E. at Sta. 3+18 per the plans 1950 description.

The request will remove 318 feet of 12 inch tile.

There are no upstream drains in this arm as the vacation begins at Sta. 0+0 per the drains 1950 description. The drainage that the existing tile serves will be accommodated by the proposed infrastructure for 1st on Main. The maintenance of this infrastructure will be the responsibility of the City of Carmel

Upon review of the request, I believe the above portion of the drain meets the requirements for for vacation as set out in IC-36-9-27-34(d). In my opinion, the vacation will not adversely affect other property owners within the drainage shed.

I recommend the Board set a hearing date for June 27, 2022.



On this 27th day of June, 2022, the Hamilton County Drainage Board has held a hearing on the Maintenance Report and Schedule of Assessments of the Morrow-Follett Drain, Donahue Arm, 1st on Main Partial Abandonment (Station 0+00 to Station 0+38 & Station 0+38 to Station 3+18).

Evidence has been heard. Objections were presented and considered. The Board then adopted an order of action. The Board now finds that the costs of continued maintenance to the portion of the above drain exceed the benefits to the real estate benefited by the portion of the drain to be abandoned and issues this order vacating the above section of the Morrow-Follett Drain, Donahue Arm, 1st on Main Partial Abandonment (Station 0+00 to Station 0+38 & Station 0+38 to Station 3+18).
