We the Viewers and Engineer, to whom the above intitled Petition

We the Viewers and Engineer, to whom the above intitled Petition for Drainage of certain lands, in Hamilton County, Indiana, was referred; Would respectfully report, that we met on the line of said proposed repair of said Elizabeth Bennett Drain, on the 30th day of October 1924, qualified and proceeded to View said Drain and the lands effected thereby.

After a careful investigation of the conditions of said Drain, we are of the opinion that said Drain is not now performing the purpose for which it was intended. The tiles being broken down in several places, and the water leaving the tiles and floting over the lands adjacent. That trees, bushes, and briars have been permitted to grow over and along said Drain, and by reason of the roots growing into said Drain, the same has been rendered useless. Knowing that such conditions exist we would recommend that said Drain be repaired, in accordance with the following.

That each of the broken down places be repaired by excavating the earth and removing the broken tiles and pieces thereof, then resurfacing the grade of said Ditch to its original true line taken from the bottom of the tiles at each end of the removed portion, That two or more of said places shall be left open at a time, for the purpose of inspecting the ditch between said points, If said points are more than 200 feet apart, or on turns where the light cannot be seen from one hole to the other, there shall be holes made in the ditch between said points by excavating and lifting out one tile at sufficient distance a part th that the light may be seen through, placing a lantern in one of the holes and looking through from the other, to ascertain whether or not the ditch is clear of obstructions and displacement of tile. Should obstructions be found or tile displaced or broken, excavations are to be made and the obstructions removed and the ditch rerepaired in the same manner and at the same rate of cost as those that are specificately mentioned and bid upon.

The Contractor shall use the best and most careful method of removing the tile, He shall lay them along the bank of the Ditch in a manner so as to protect them from injury, so that the greatest amount possible will be available for relaying in the ditch,

After he has respected the ditch to its proper depths he shall relay all uninjured tiles, He will then accertain the number of new tiles of the different dimensions needed to complate the line of tile, which tiles he will furnish and lay to the proper grades and line with joints well matched.

After the work above mentioned has been performed, the excavations shall be refilled over and around the tiles with earth.

In case there is not sufficient earth obtained from the excavations to bring the filling to the level of the surrounding ground, the contractor shall borrow a sufficient amount to complete said filling.

All bushes, briars to be grubbed for a distance of 5 feet, and all trees to be deadened for a distance of 25 feet on each side of the drain for its entire length,

All tiles, to be first class and shall be inspected, and approved, by the superintendent of construction, and the work to be inspected in every stage, weaken before they are laid in the ditch, by the Superintendent of construction, and he shall inspect the work in each stage of its progress, and said work, and material shall be to his satisfaction and approval.

Asupplement, to said drain having been heretofore constructed, beginning at Sand Creek and watending across the lands of Assistance and intersecting the original drain at a point about 20 Rods east of the original drain and should be made a part of said drain as now serving as a part of said drain and should be made a part of said drain original drain for this and future repairs and should be given the same consideration as other parts of said original drain.

The superintendent in charge shall keep an accurate account of the amount done as said work progresses, and shall pay for all work done materials furnished at the contract price for same, together with all necessary expenses including Attorney fees, Court expenses, Legal printing, Superintending the Construction, Cost of Viewers and Engineer in making the necessary surveys examination of premises and the making of this report, and all other expenses incident to the establishment and construction of said work as the Court shall deem proper, out of funds collected from the assessments made by the Viewers and confirmed by the Court.

For the purpose of raising funds for making such payments the superintendent shall collect promate of the assessments set out below, which assessments are the same as made by the Viewers for the original construction of said drain.

Said collections to be made in accordance with the law for collections made for the original construction of ditches.

The price bid for the execution of the work and for materials furnished to repair said drain shall be made upon the unit price per cubic yard of excavation and fill and per lineal foot of new tiles furnished, and for the taking up an and relaying of the old tiles.

Having no way before the work is dome to accertain the amount of excavation, or the amount of work to be done, and the X amount of materials to be furnished, we have estimated the same as follows:
