Re: Booth-Snead Drain #129

Attached is a petition and plans for the proposed relocation of the Booth-Snead Drain. The relocation is being proposed by R. N. Thompson. The proposal is to relocate the existing tile drain between Sta. 19+00 and Sta. 54+60 as an open ditch.

This line will consist of 3,850 feet of open ditch as shown on the plans by Evergreen Planners, Inc. dated June 3, 1999.

The total length of new open ditch shall be 3,850 feet. The 3,560 feet of original tile drain between Sta. 19+00 and Sta. 54+60 shall be vacated. This proposal will add an additional 290 feet to the drains total length.

The reconstruction will affect two property owners, Mays Property Management Company and Lois L Shonkwiler Trust. The easement on both properties will increase beyond the existing 75 feet easement from the centerline of the existing tile to the 75 feet from the top of each bank of the new open ditch. A crossing shall be provided on the Shonkwiler property at a location to be determined by Shonkwiler's.

I recommend the Board increase the current  $\pounds 3.00$  minimum to a \$10.00 minimum assessment.

The cost of the relocation is to be paid by R. N. Thompson.

RE: Booth-Snead Drain

This is a revision of my reconstruction report for the Booth-Snead Drain dated December 23, 1999. I recommend that the proposed reconstruction be shortened at this time so that the lower end of the drain is reconstructed from Sta. 36+10 to Sta. 54+60 of the existing tile. This is from Sta. 0 to Sta. 18+50 on the plans by Evergreen Planners, Inc. dated June 3, 1999.

The new open ditch will be 1,850 feet in length. The 1,850 feet of original tile drain between Sta. 36+10 and Sta. 54+60 shall be vacated. This proposal will not add to nor subtract from the drain's length.

This revision would place all work on the property of Mays
Property Management Co., eliminating the work, additional easement and
crossing the Shonkwiler property. All other portions of the report
remain as submitted.

During construction, there were no significant changes made to the drainage plans submitted with my report for this drain dated April 20, 2000. 




