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REPORT OF COMMISSIONERS.

To the Honorable Judge of the Hamilton Circuit Court:

The undersigned, Commissioners of Drainage, to whom was referred the petition of Aurora Sechrist & James M. Wheel, for the drainage of the North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section 20, the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section 17, the South West quarter of the South West quarter and the North West quarter of the South West quarter of Section 18, all in Township 18 North Range five East

in Hamilton County, respectfully report that they have inspected personally all the lands described in said petition, and all other lands liable to be affected by the construction of the proposed work, and are of the opinion that the proposed drainage will improve the public health of that neighborhood, will benefit three public highways and will be of public utility in the county and that the same can be accomplished at an expense less than the aggregate benefits to the lands affected thereby, and after causing the necessary surveys and examinations to be made, they determined that the method of drainage should be as follows, to wit;
See page 5 of this report.

They estimate the cost of constructing the work at nine hundred & seventy five dollars. They further report that they have estimated the benefits and injury

to the several tracts of land which will be affected by the work, as follows:

By the construction of a ditch commen-
encing 10 rods east of the North West
corner of Section 21 Township 18 North Range
5 East and running thence S. 20° E. 900 feet
then e. $33\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E. 300 feet, thence S. 70° E. 400 feet, thence
S. 41° E. 700 feet, thence south 200 feet, thence S. 38° W.
200 feet, thence S. 14° W. 1400 feet, thence S. 35° W. 160
feet, thence S. 48° E. 370 feet, thence S. 45° E. 200 feet, thence
East 100 feet, thence S. 32° E. 250 feet, thence S. 28° E.
350 feet, thence S. 9° E. 400 feet, thence S. 43° E. 300 feet
thence South 2288 feet and terminates at a stake
marked 86 40 rods west and 9 rods North of
the South East corner of the North West quarter
of Section 28 Township 18 North Range 5 East.

We are of the opinion that said ditch should
be tiled with four tier of seven inch tile from
the beginning to 4000 feet from the beginning
that in excavating said ditch the two tier of
seven inch tile be taken up and the tile used
in the new ditch.

The following is a tabular statement
of the depth of cut and width at top and bottom
at the beginning of said ditch and at the end
of each 100 feet thereof, together with the number
of each 10 cubic yards of earth to be removed
from each 100 feet the estimated cost per cubic
yard the cost per 100 feet and the total number
of cubic yards of earth to be removed and the
total cost of removing the same.
