
On December 12, 1984, I made an onsite inspection of the Hawthorne Hills Drain, Section 1. At this time I found the drain to be complete and acceptable with no construction changes being made to the drain.

The drain consists of 1990 feet of 6" plastic tile and approximately 200 feet of open ditch for a total of 2190 feet.

Because of the wooded nature of the area, I recommend that copper sulfate be placed in the access points each year. This will help keep roots out of the system and will be an inexpensive method of doing so.
