Attached is a petition, non-enforcement request, plans, calculations, quanity summary and assessment roll for the Legends at Geist Drain, Spy Glass Hill Section 2 Arm.

I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accuring to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

The total length of the drain will be 13,325 feet.

The retention pond located between Lots 65 and 66 and the William McKinstry Drain is not to be considered part of the regulated drain. Only the inlet and outlet will be maintained as part of the regulated drain. The maintenance of the lake will be the responsibility of the Home Owners Association. The Board shall, however, reserve the jurisdiction of ensuring that the volume of retention remains under the Drainage Code. The lake may in the future be enlarged by the Developer.

The open ditch shown above reflects that open ditch which is riprapped between structure 48 and the retention area. This ditch crossess Lots

The subsurface drains (SSD) to be part of the regulated drain are those located under the curbs and those main lines between lots or in rear yards. Only the main SSD lines which are located within the easement are to be maintained as regulated drain. Laterals for individual lots will not be considered part of the regulated drain. The portion of the SSD which will be regulated other than those under curbs are as

Rear of Lots 54-55,57-61,13-15,18-20,24,24-26,28-31,16&17,37-40,41, 48&49,47,43,69-71

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$50.00 per lot, \$5.00 per acre for roadways, with a \$50.00 minimum. With this assessment the total annual assessment for the drain/this section will be \$3,055.00. At sometime in the future this drainage area may also be assessed to the William McKinstry Drain and/or Mud Creek.

I recommend a hearing be set for December 1992.

If the hearing is approved, I recommend the Board approve the attached non-enforcement request for the secondary plat for Spy Glass Hill Section 2.

I futher recommend the Board classify this drain as an Urban Drain.




