The Board now proceed to examine the Bonds in
Plaint as procured by the Auditor in accordance with
the order of the Board made Aug 17th 1893 and find same
to be as ordered

Therefore the Board does now issue "Funding County Bonds"
numbered from One (1) to twenty (20) inclusive each for the sum
of One thousand dollars making a total sum of principal in
the sum of Twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) with Coupons
attached at the rate of 6% per annum Payable Semiannually on
the 16th day of February and August of each year beginning with the
16th day of February 1894 each Coupon being for the sum of Thirty dollars

The said Bonds to mature two years after date
payable Principal and Interest at the Banking House of
Mussler Sauer & Co in the City and State of New York.

And the Bonds are now duly signed in Open
Court by the Board of Commissioners of Hamilton County
Auditors and Certified and sealed by the Auditor of
said County

And the Auditor is directed to deliver said
Bonds to the Treasurer of Hamilton County Auditors
taking his receipt therefor.

Comes now the petitioners and file their supplemental
petition in said matter showing that the description
of said drain as described in the petition heretofore
filed does not run down the natural channel along
which said drain is constructed so as to furnish
fall sufficient to properly drain petitioners land and

terminus of the drain as described in said petition
in a southwesterly course along or near the original

To the Honorable Board of Commissioners of Hamilton County
We the undersigned appointed by this Court at its June
Session 1894 to view a drain described in the Certified
Copy of a Petition and Order of Court for a Ditch by Andrew
J Breedlove and others handed us by the Auditor would
represent that according to said Order we on the
day named therein to wit the 18 day of June 1894 in
Company with J S Bayser a Civil Engineer made
an accurate survey of the line of said proposed Ditch from
its source to its outlet a plat of said Ditch is filed herewith
including the survey by the Engineer. We caused stakes to be
set along said line each one hundred feet numbered
down stream as shown by plat We also made a computation
of the total number of cubic yards of earth to be removed
from said Drain and estimated the total cost of
Construction of the work at \$3,074 ⁸⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars We also
apportioned and set apart to each parcel of land a
share of said work in proportion to the Benefits
accrued all of which will fully appear by a total
Statement in this report We have also set out a table
below the names of the Owners of lands benefited with
a description of each tract of land and the amount
assessed against each tract The depth of cut and width at
bottom and width at top along said Drain is also
shown in a Tabular Statement in this report After a full
and Careful view and Examination we are of the opinion
that the Drain as located by the survey will be of public
utility and benefit to the health and that the cost will
not exceed the benefits derived therefrom as should be
an open ditch located as follows to wit

Ditch to be an open Ditch to have a slope of one foot Horizontal to one vertical and to be 16 feet wide in the Bottom from Station 0 to Station 99 from Station 99 to terminus 5 feet wide all excavated material to be thrown back 2 feet beyond the edge of Ditch bank and dirt to be thrown in the washout all Brush stumps logs to be moved at least 1 Rod from the Ditch all dirt excavated from the Ditch when left in 2 feet of the edge of Ditch to have a slope corresponding with Ditch Depth of Cutting to be ascertained by straight edge and level off of Top of Station Stake
