Attached is a petition, non-enforcement request, plans, calculations, and assessment roll for the Walrond Road Drain, Section 2.

I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefitted. The drain will consist of the following:

6inch SSD 520 feet

The total length of the drain will be 520 feet.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$30.00 per lot, \$2.00 per acre for roadways, with a \$10.00 minimum. With this assessment the total annual assessment for the drain/this section will be \$340.00.

I recommend a hearing be set for August 11, 1986

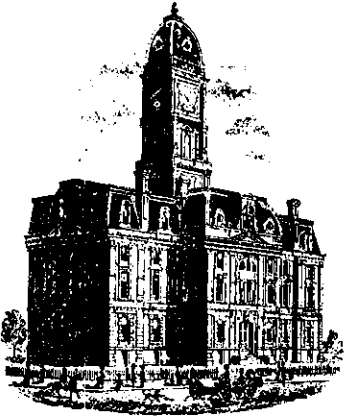

Attached are as-builts, certificate of completion and compliance and other information for Walrond Road Drain, Section 2. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes were made to the drain which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain dated June 9, 1986. The changes are as follows:


- 16ft of 12" RCP serving as outlet of pond on Lots 6 and 8.
- 5ft of open RipRap drain between pond outlet above and street
- 190ft of 6" SSD added between Lot 3 and 7.
- 460ft of 6" SSD added to North side of Street, stubs not placed
- 20ft of 8" CMP added to 6" SSD outlet into pond on Lot 16.

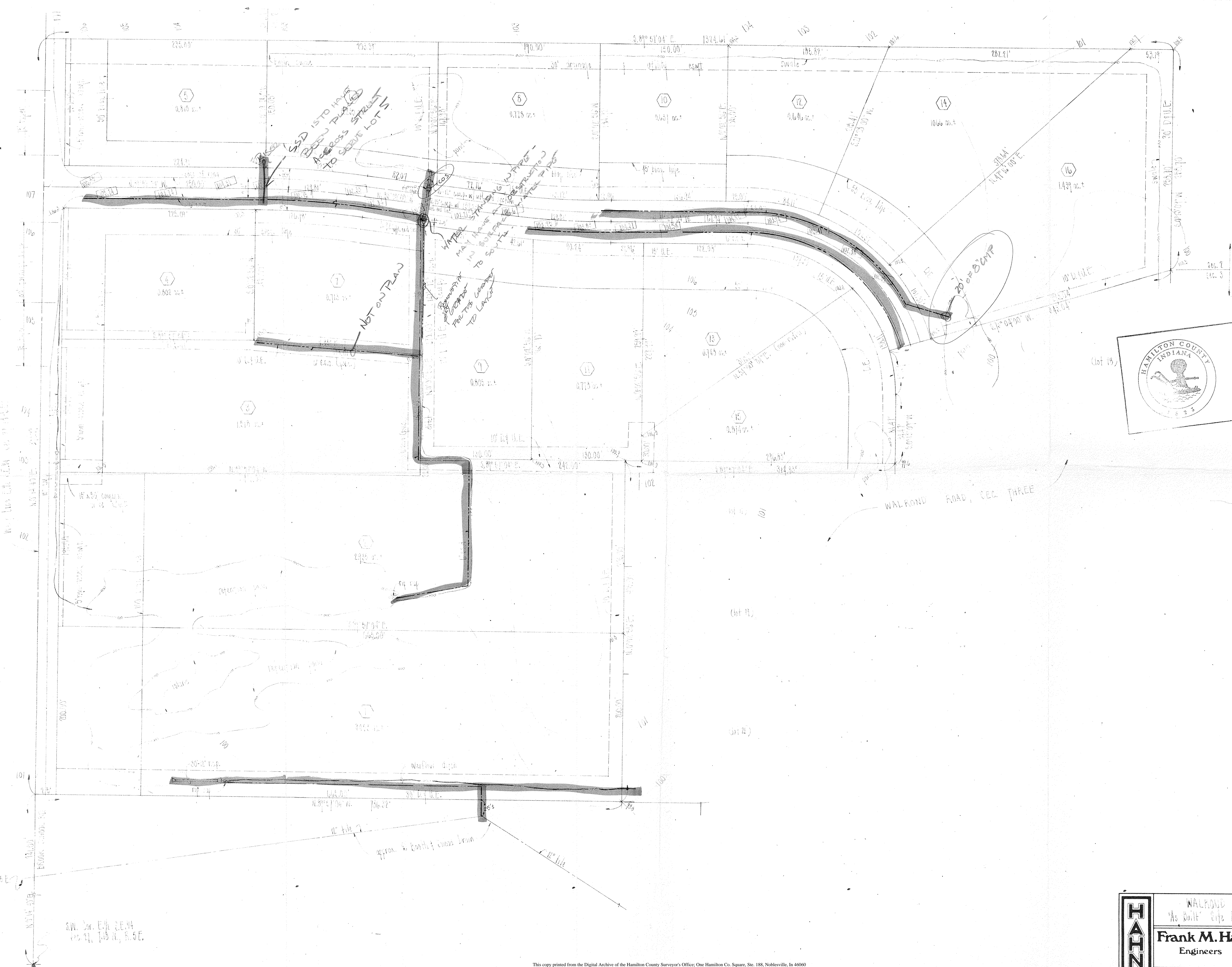
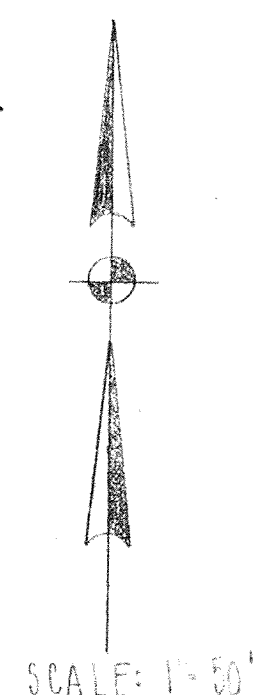
The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now 1161 feet.

The ponds are not part of the regulated drain and are the responsibility of each homeowner.


