

Attached are as-builts, certificate of completion and compliance and other information for Walrond Road Drain, Section 2 An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes were made to the drain which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain dated June 9, 1986. The changes are as follows:

16ft of 12" RCP serving as outlet of pond on Lots 6 and 8.

5ft of open RipRap drain between pond outlet above and street

190ft of 6" SSD added between Lot 3 and 7.

460ft of 6" SSD added to North side of Street, stubs not placed 20ft of 8" CMP added to 6" SSD outlet into pond on Lot 16.

The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now 1161 feet.

The ponds are not part of the regulated drain and are the responsibility of each homeowner.

Attached also is a non-enforcement request for the drain which I recommend that the Board approve at this time.
