

Attached is a petition for reconstruction of the Mary Nagle Fain.

The petition has been submitted by Shorewood in order to relocate a portion of the drain.

The portion to be reconstructed is in the area at Toll Gate Road. existing tile portion of the drain now outlets at or near Station 52+00. The proposed work will involve from Station 52+00 to Station 53+12 on the original drain. In this area, two 71" x 47" CMPA's will be installed. Along with this, the open ditch from Toll Gate Road to the Reservoir will be straightened, erosion control installed and cleaned of debris. This work is shown on plans dated 12-18-87, file stamped December 31, 1987, by Paul I. Cripe, Inc., Sheets 1, 3, 6 and 13.

The proposed work will replace the drain from Station 52 to Station 53+12 with 140' of twin 71"  $\times$  47" GMPA. It will then extend the open ditch approximately 580 feet to Morse Reservoir. The new length of the drain upon completion will be 5920 feet.

Along with this project, I recommend the minimum assessment be increased from \$3.00 to \$25.00.

A hearing for this work should be held in March 1988.

Attached are the plans for the Mary Nagle Reconstruction for as-builts and certificate of completion & compliance see Morse Landing Sec. 4. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction of the drain there were not any significant changes made to the drain. Subsequently, there were not any significant changes made to the plans submitted with my report dated January 8, 1988. Therefore, the length of the drain remains at **5,920 feet**.

All expenses were paid for by the petitioner, Shorewood Corporation.

I recommend the Board approve the drains construction as complete and acceptable.
