Re: Margaret O'brien Drain, Arm 2 - Concourse at Crosspoint Building 2 Extension

Attached is a petition and plans for the proposed extension of the Margaret O'brien Drain, Crosspoint Business Park Arm. The petition is being proposed by John Edgeworth of Edgeworth Laskey Properties, LLC for E-L Crosspoint Building 2 LLP. The proposal is to extend a portion of the drain on parcel 15-14-12-00-03-001.108 owned by E-L Crosspoint Building 2 LLP and parcel 15-14-12-00-03-001.008, owned by E-L Crosspoint 1 LLP as part of the Concourse at Crosspoint Building 2 project per plans by American Structurepoint, Job No. 02011-00570 revision date 10/18/2013.

Per the plans, the existing drain will be extended on the site to accommodate land improvements which include parking.

This extension will consist of the following:

17' of 24" RCP

The total length of new drain pipe shall be 17 feet. The new pipe will be installed upstream of existing Str. 71A. The existing drain and Str. 71A is referenced in my previous report to the Board dated June 30, 1986 and approved at hearing on August 11, 1986 as recorded in Drainage Board minutes book 2, page 156.

The cost of the project is to be paid by the developer. The developer has provided the Bond as follows:

Attached is a Non-enforcement Request. The easement for the drain will continue the same dimensions (25' per half/50' total) as previously approved by the Board for the existing pipe on March 25th, 2002 (Inst. No. 200200027354). As part of this project, the developer requests to encroach into the easement with parking. The project has been designed to accommodate emergency flood routing across the site. I recommend approval of the Non-enforcement by the Board.

The project falls under the requirements as set out in IC 36-9-27-52.5. Therefore, the hearing for the petition does not require public notice. I recommend approval of the petition.

During construction, changes were made to the drain, which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain-dated April 28, 2014. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held April 28, 2014. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 15, Pages 393-394)

The changes are as follows:

12" RCP was shortened from 17 feet to 12 feet.

The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now 12 feet.

The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on April 28, 2014 and recorded under instrument #2014015446.


