The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on 8-11-86.

The drainage facilities for this section intercepts the Overman-Harvey legal drain as per the plat for Village Farms Section 4B. The connection to Section 4B takes place at the northwest corner of Lot 245 of Section 4A and Lot 300 of Section 4A. Section 4A outlets into the lake.
