





Attached is a petition, non-enforcement request, plans and schedule of assessments as submitted by the Carmel Clay School Board for the Carmel West Elementary School Arm of the O.F. Henely Drain. The schedule of assessments shows the name and address of each owner, the legal description, parcel number as shown by the tax duplicate or record of transfers by the County Auditor wherein the land is situated, which lands, in my opinion, will be affected by the proposed improvement and the public roads or highway owned by the County or by the State of Indiana by name or number and the Right of Ways of railroads by section, township and range.

I have reviewed the submittals and petition which was referred to me on June 18, 1992 and have found each to be in proper form. I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefitted.

The drain consists of the following of 1341 feet of 24" RCP, which was constructed by the School Board as the offsite storm sewer for the Carmel West Elementary School. The location of the drainage facility is shown on the attached plan. The storm sewer is proposed to be part of the O.F. Henley Drain as the Carmel West Elementary Arm of the drain.

The maintenance work required for the said tile drain includes the repairing of tile, structures, maintaining the outlet

and any other work necessary which will keep the tile in proper working order as and when needed.

I recommend a maintenance assessment remain as is for the per acre assessment and increase the current \$3.00 minimum to a \$5.00 minimum.

I recommend a hearing be set for September 1992. I also recommend the Board approve the attached non-enforcement request at that time.
