RE: Paulsel & Vance & Peter Paulsel Drain - Lochaven 9C Relocation

Attached is a petition, recorded drainage easement, subdivision non-enforcement and asbuilt plans for the section of storm pipe located between the Lochaven Lake (10-10-14-00-07-030.000) in Lochaven and the Martin Marietta Lake (aka Precedent/Peterson Lake) on Parcel 10-10-14-00-00-007.002. The installation of the 12" pipe completes the reconstruction of the Paulsel, Vance & Peter Paulsel Drain that was started with the Lochaven Sec. 9A reconstruction hearing held on January 24, 2011 (HCDB Minute Book 13, Pages 247-249).

The proposal is for the relocation of the Paulsel Vance Paulsel Drain between Lots 203-204 and across Spayside Drive East to the Martin Marietta Lake (aka Precedent/Peterson Lake). This proposal includes the lengths of storm sewer between the following structure numbers: 137, 136 and 135. Also, the overflow pipe between structures 138 and 136 per plans by HWC Engineering; Job Number 2015-138, Pages C1.1 and C6.2, dated November 30, 2015.

The length of new storm pipe between the Lochaven Lake and Martin Marietta Lake (aka Precedent/Peterson Lake) is as follows:

12" RCP - 412 feet

The additional new open drain with this final relocation shall be the lengths between the following structures/stations installed with the previous 146th Street, Lochaven 9A and Precedent relocations of the Paulsel Vance Paulsel drain over the last 18 years. The following

lengths of new open drain are as follows: Between existing Structure 635 of the Lochaven Sec. 9A Re-location approved by the Board January 24, 2011 (HCDB Minute Book 13, Pages 247-249) to Structure 137 of the proposed Lochaven Sec. 9C Re-location proposed between Lots 203-204. Then from Structure 135 located east of Lots 203-204 on the Martin Marietta Lake (aka Precedent/ Peterson Lake) property (10-10-14-00-00-007.002) to approximate Sta. 40+05. Station 40+05 is on the new open drain alignment between the existing 42" outlet (Sta. 28+05) installed with the 146th Street Re-location approved by the Board July 26, 2004 (HCDB Minute Book 7, Pages 511- 513) and existing Structure 1 (Sta. 46+32) located at the northeast corner of the Martin Marietta Lake (aka Precedent/Peterson Lake) installed with the Precedent relocation approved by the Board on March 27, 2000 (HCDB Minute Book 5, Pages 331-333).

New Open Drain - 4152'

The total length of new storm pipe and open drain shall be 4564 feet.

Along with this new storm pipe construction by Pulte Homes, Martin Marietta has requested portions of the Paulsel Vance Paulsel Drain be vacated in order to expand their mining operations at their River Road site.

The original Paulsel, Vance & Paulsel drain per the 1891 legal description located between Sta. 31+90 and 69+16 and Sta. 42+82 and Sta. 60+67 shall be vacated as requested by Martin Marietta. Also, the existing open drain between Sta. 28+05 and Sta. 42+82 shall be vacated too and re-aligned between stations 28+05 to 46+32, the proposal will remove 6988 feet from the drains total length.

The net between the new storm pipe and open ditch and the vacation is a reduction of 2424 feet from the drains total length.

The new storm pipe construction between the lakes was proposed and paid for by Pulte Homes of Indiana, LLC.

The petitioner, Pulte Homes of Indiana LLC, provided a Performance Bond to the Hamilton County Board of Commissioners as follows:

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Secondary Plat for Lochaven Sec. 9A as recorded in the Hamilton County Recorder's Office, Plat Cabinet 4, Slide 159.

Attached is a non-enforcement for Lochaven Sec. 9C. The easement for the reconstructed Paulsel Vance Paulsel Drain will be per the Secondary Plat for Lochaven Sec. 9C as recorded in the Hamilton County Recorder's Office, Plat Cabinet 5, Slide 592. I recommend the Board approve this non-enforcement request upon approval of this report.

I recommend that the Board set a hearing for this proposal for April 23, 2018.

FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the **Paulsel**, **Vance & Peter Paulsel Drain**, **Lochaven Section 9C Relocation** came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing on April 23, 2018, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the **Paulsel, Vance & Peter Paulsel Drain, Lochaven Section 9C Relocation** be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:

Attached are as-built, certificate of completion & compliance, and other information for Lochaven Section 9C Relocation. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes were made to the drain, which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain-dated March 1, 2018. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held April 23, 2018. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 18, Pages 106-108) The changes are as follows: the 12" RCP remained at 412 feet. The open ditch was lengthened from 4,152 feet to 4,168 feet. The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now **4,580 feet**. With this project 6,988 feet of original tile and open ditch. Overall the drain lost 2,408 feet in length.

The non-enforcements were approved by the Board at its meetings on January 24, 2011 and April 23, 2018. They were then recorded under instrument #'s 2018008473 and 2018017299. Another drainage easement for this project was recorded under instrument # 2017000960.

The following sureties were guaranteed by International Fidelity Insurance Company and released by the Board on its April 23, 2018 meeting.


