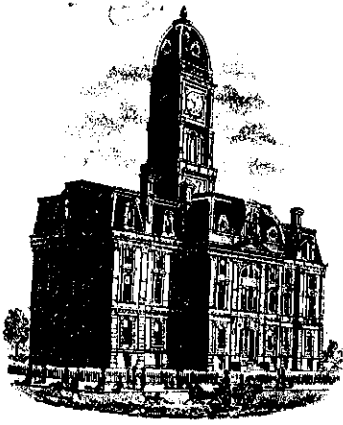

Attached is a petition and location map for the extension of the Henry Plew Drain from the Hamilton County Commissioners. The drain shown in the petition as Exhibit "B" is an existing drain. The location shown is approximate and is described as follows:

Beginning at a point West of Horton Road on the North side of the Monon Railroad then North East to Horton Road then North along the West edge of Horton Road to its outlet in the Henry Plew Drain. The size of the tile is ten or twelve (10" or 12") inch. The length is approximately 1150 feet.

The tile has been repaired by the County Highway Department several times in recent years. At this time it is believed that the tile is in working order.

Presently, the Plew Drain is assessed \$.50 per acre, \$3.00 minimum with 725 acres assessed and has a balance of \$872.00. I do not believe that the drainage shed will change with this proposal nor believe that the assessment should be increased.

I recommend a hearing be set for July 14, 1986.
