

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF HAMILTON COUNTY, INDIANA

We, the undersigned, appointed by this Court, at its October Term, 1900, to review a drain described in the certified copy of a petition and order of Court for a Drain, by M. E. Scherer and others, handed us by the Auditor, would represent that according to said order we, on the day named therein, to-wit: The 16th day of October, 1900, in company with J. A. Mitchell, a civil engineer, made an accurate survey of the line of the said proposed Ditch, from its source to its outlet. A plat of the said proposed Ditch is filed herewith, including the survey by the engineer, marked "Exhibit B." We caused stakes to be set along said line, each one hundred feet, numbering down stream, as shown by plat. We also made a computation of the total number of cubic yards of sarth to be removed from said drain, and estimated the total cost for the construction of the work at One Thousand and Fifty (\$1050.00) Dollars. We have set out, by a statement below, the names of the owners of the lands benefited, with a description of each tract of land, and the amount assessed against each tract. The depth of cut, the width od bottom, Athe width of top along drain, is also shown in a tabular statement in this report. stake 48-54 to stake 48+70, and a stone retaining wall at station 48+70 in dimensions  $2\times6\times15$ .

All tile used must be first class in every respect and must be laid in the ditch at the proper grade and in a true line with the joints well matched, and must be left uncovered until inspected by the engineer in charge. After being inspected and accepted by the engineer the tile must be covered by placing the

earth excavated in and over the line of the ditch and in such places as the ditch is constructed in an old open channel the banks of said channel must be drawn in so as to cover the tile to a depth of not less than 18 inches in any place.

The stone wall to be placed at station 48+70 to be built of field rock or niger heads laid up in mortar made from one part cement to three parts good sharp sand. The wall to be so constructed as to receive the tile at the proper grade and 1/1/2 feet above the base of the wall.

The fall of the established grade of the main ditch, or the ditch to be constructed, is thirty one hundredths (30/100) feet to the one hundred (100) feet from station 0 to station 8 and fifeteen one-hundredths (15/100) feet to the one hundred (100) feet from station 8 to station 22, and twenty-five one hundredths (25/100) feet to the one hundred (100) feet from station 22 to station 40, and coghty one-hundredths (30/100) feet to the one hundred (100) feet to the one hundred (100) feet to the one
