Attached is a petition filed by Boomerang Development, LLC. along with a non-enforcement request, plans, calculations, quantity summary and assessment roll for the Claybourne Section 2 Arm, Albert Shaw Drain to be located in Clay Township. I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable, will improve the public health, benefit a public highway, and be of public utility and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

6" SSD 4,484 ft. 15" RCP 577 ft. 12" RCP 486 ft. 18" RCP 171 ft.

The total length of the drain will be 5,718 feet.

The subsurface drains (SSD) to be part of the regulated drain are those located under the curbs. Only the main SSD lines which are located within the right of way are to be maintained as regulated drain. Laterals for individual lots will not be considered part of the regulated drain.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I also believe that no damages will result to landowners by the construction of this drain. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$10.00 per acre for common areas, \$45.00 per platted lot, \$10.00 per acre for roadways, with a \$45.00 minimum. With this assessment the total annual assessment for this drain/this section will be \$1,188.50.

The petitioner has submitted surety for the proposed drain at this time. Surety shall be submitted prior to the approval of the Hamilton County Board of Commissioners/commencement of construction. The sureties which are in the form of a Performance Bond are as follows:

Parcels assessed for this drain may be assessed for the Boone Creek Drain at sometime in the future.

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

I recommend that upon approval of the above proposed drain that the Board also approve the attached non-enforcement request. The request is for the reduction of the regulated drain easement to those easement widths as shown on the secondary plat for Claybourne, Section 2 as recorded in the office of the Hamilton County Recorder.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposed drain for January 26, 2004.
