Attached are as-builts, certificate of completion & compliance, and other information for Village Farms Sec. 18 Reconstruction of the Springmill Ponds Drain. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, there were no significant changes made to the drainage plans submitted with my report for this drain dated November 13, 2000.
