

Attached is a petition filed by Precedent Development along with a non-enforcement request, plans, calculations, quantity summary and assessment roll for the Fox Hollow Section 1 Arm, Springs of Cambridge Drain to be located in Fall Creek Township. I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable, will improve the public health, benefit a public highway, and be of public utility and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

6" SSD	7,024 ft.	15" RCP	1,092	ft.
12" RCP	762 ft.	18" RCP	421	ft.

The total length of the drain will be 9,299 feet.

The retention pond located in RCA # 1 is to be considered part of the regulated drain. Only the inlet and outlet will be maintained as part of the regulated drain. The maintenance of the pond, such as mowing, will be the responsibility of the Homeowners Association. The Board will however retain jurisdiction for ensuring the storage volume for which the lake was designed will be retained. Thereby, allowing no fill or easement encroachments.

The subsurface drains (SSD) to be part of the regulated drain are those located under the curbs and those main lines between lots or in rear yards. Only the main SSD lines which are located within the easement (right of way) are to be maintained as regulated drain. Laterals for individual lots will not be considered part of the regulated drain. The portion of the SSD which will be regulated other than those under curbs are as follows: Rear of lots 15, 16, 17, 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I also believe that no damages will result to landowners by the construction of this drain. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$ 5.00 per acre for common areas and platted lots, \$ 5.00 per acre for roadways, with a \$ 30.00 minimum. With this assessment the total annual assessment for this drain/this section will be \$ 1,307.70.

The petitioner has submitted surety for the proposed drain at this time. Surety shall be submitted prior to the approval of the Hamilton County Board of Commissioners/commencement of construction. The sureties which are in the form of a Performance Bond/Letter of Credit are as follows:

Parcels assessed for this drain may be assessed for the Bee Camp Drain at sometime in the future.

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

I recommend that upon approval of the above proposed drain that the Board also approve the attached non-enforcement request. The request is for the reduction of the regulated drain easement to those easement widths as shown on the secondary plat for Fox Hollow at Geist, Section 1 as recorded in the office of the Hamilton County Recorder.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposed drain for November 24, 2003.
