Re: Stony Creek Drain, Stony Creek Golf Club Extension

Attached is a drain map for the extension of the Stony Creek Drain. This proposed drain is located in Noblesville Township.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described below. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable, will improve the public health, benefit a public highway and be of public utility and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of 690 feet of open ditch.

This extension will consist of the section of Stony Creek which runs across the northeastern portion of the Stony Creek Golf Club. This section begins at the east line of tract 11-11-04-00-00-021.000 which is the terminus of the Highlands at Stony Creek Extension as described in my report to the Board dated February 15, 2008 and approved by the Board on June 9, 2008 (Hamilton County Drainage Board Minutes Book 11, Pages 198-200). The drain will run 690 feet in an westerly direction, downstream following the existing creek to the north line of the above referenced tract which is the beginning of the Stoney Creek Estates Extension as described in my report dated February 15, 2008 and approved by the Board on May 27, 2008 (Hamilton County Drainage Board Minutes Book 11, Pages 155-158).

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

The nature of maintenance work required is as follows:

- 1. Bank erosion protection and/or seeding as might be required;
- 2. Removal of debris and/or blockages from existing open drain;
- 3. Removal of beaver dams;
- 4. Any other repairs necessary to restore proper flow to the open ditch.

The frequency with which maintenance work should be performed is annually as required by the condition of the drain.

The easements for the drain should be set at 75' from top of bank as set out in IC 36-9-27-33. Additional drainage easement will be added to the following tracts:



#### FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the **Stony Creek Drain, Stony Creek Golf Club Extension** came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing **on June 22, 2009**, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{Evidence}}$  was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the **Stony Creek Drain, Stony Creek Golf Club Extension** be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:
