RE: E.O. Michaels Drain, Hull Arm

Attached is a petition, plans, drain map and schedule of assessments for the Hull Arm to the E.O. Michaels Drain. This proposed arm is located in Wayne Township.

The petition for this arm was filed on March 22, 2012 by William M. and Amanda M. Hull in order to provide their parcel, tax parcel 12-07-25-00-00-015.004, subsurface drainage access to the E.O. Michaels Drain.

The drain will begin at a point approximately ten (10) feet south of the north property line for the above referenced Hull tract as described in inst. #2012013218 as recorded in the Hamilton County Recorder's Office. Said point being on the east right of way for Durbin Road. The drain shall run thence north 110 feet terminating in Arm 3 of the E.O. Michaels Drain at or near Station 13+38 which is on existing east 16.5 foot half right of way line of Durbin Road.

The cost estimate for the drain is as follows:

The cost of the proposed arm shall be paid by the petitioner. The construction of the proposed arm shall not cause changes to the current maintenance assessment for the Michaels Drain.

The drain will be installed on the existing 16.5 foot half right of way line for Durbin Road. The drain will lie within the east right of way for Durbin Road, parcel 12-07-25-00-00-015.004 owned by William M. & Amanda M. Hull and parcel 12-07-25-00-00-015.000 owned by Ted and Ryo Essig. The easement for this arm shall consist of the 50 foot platted easement for "Thoroughbred Estates" as recorded in the office of the Hamilton County Recorder as instrument # 200300048491 and #200300048470. The 50 foot drainage and utility easement as platted is measured from the east side of the existing 16.5 foot half right of way line for Durbin Road. The northern 75 feet of the new arm is also within the existing 75 foot statutory easement for the E.O. Michaels Drain.

I recommend the Board set a hearing date for this proposed arm for December 10, 2012.



FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the *E. O. Michaels Drain, Hull Arm* came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing *on December 10, 2012,* on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the **E. O. Michaels Drain, Hull Arm** be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:


The Board issued an order declaring the proposed improvement established. Such findings and order were marked filed and are available for inspection in the Office of the Hamilton County Surveyor.

FINAL INSPECTION REPORT

Please regard this letter as the final report on the E.O. Michaels Drain, Hull Arm in Section 25, Township 19 North, Range 5 East, in Wayne Township, Hamilton County, Indiana.

The hearing for the William Hull Arm to the E.O. Michaels Drain was held on December 10, 2013 (Hamilton County Drainage Board Minutes Book 14, page 433) at which time the Board approved the Surveyor's report dated November 5, 2012.

The Hamilton County Drainage Board awarded the contract for the amount of \$966.55 on February 11, 2013 to John Ward Excavating (Hamilton County Drainage Board Minutes Book 14, page 506).

Installation of the William Hull Arm to the E.O. Michaels Drain was on March 14, 2013.

As of the date of this report, I hereby attest to and agree that the arm was installed according to the specified plans. There were no change orders on this project. All inspections have been completed.

On April 24, 2013 a bill for \$966.55 was sent to Mr. Hull for payment.


As constructed the William Hull Arm to the E.O. Michaels Drain consists of 110' feet of 6" dual wall HDPE pipe. The outlet of the tile is located approximately 900 feet south of the Northwest corner of the Southeast quarter of Section 25, Township 19 North Rage 5 East in Wayne Township, Hamilton County, Indiana, at the junction box on the east side of Durbin Road on Arm 3 of the E.O. Michaels Drain. The tile then runs south 110' feet along the east side of Durbin Road and terminates at a 6" CMP riser set on parcel # 12-07-25-00-00-015.004, owned by William Hull.

Re: Stony Creek: E. O. Michaels Drain - Hull Arm

Attached are as-builts, certificate of completion & compliance, and other information for E.O. Michaels – Hull Arm. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes there were no significant changes made to the drainage plans submitted with my report for this drain dated November 5, 2012. The report was approved by the Board on December 10, 2013. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 14, Pages 433) Therefore, the length of the drain remains at **110 feet**.

The drainage easement was outlined in my report dated November 5, 2013. The project was paid for by the petitioner. The check was submitted on May 6, 2013 (Quietus #55851) for the full amount of \$966.65.

I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.
