RE: Charles Huffman Drain/Stony Creek Drain

On October 27, 1997 the Board held a hearing to establish the Charles Huffman Drain maintenance assessment and reconstruction. (See Surveyor's Report dated August 11, 1997, Drainage Board Minutes Book 4, Pages 456-458). The rate of assessment for the drain was set at \$2.00 per acre with a \$10.00 minimum. This rate collects \$4,650.00 from Hamilton County and \$944.72 from Madison County annually and the balance within the fund is \$20,230.38. Collections for the drain were stopped in 2006.

At present the Charles Huffman Drain maintenance assessment affects 2,265.38 acres in Hamilton County and 940.07 acres in Madison County. In order to consolidate this drain with both existing drains and future drains within the Stony Creek Drainage Shed, and since the Charles Huffman Drain is a sub-shed to the overall Stony Creek Drainage Area, I recommend to the Board that the name of the drain be changed from Charles Huffman Drain to the Stony Creek Drainage Area.

I further recommend that the Board modify the current maintenance assessment as follows:

- 1. Maintenance assessment for roads and streets be set at \$10.00 per acre.
- 2. Maintenance assessment for agricultural tracts increase the \$10.00 minimum to \$15.00 minimum.
- 3. Maintenance assessment for non-platted residential tracts increase the \$10.00 minimum to \$15.00 minimum.

- 4. Maintenance assessment for commercial, institutional and multi-family residential tracts be set at \$10.00 per acre with a \$75.00 minimum.
- 5. Maintenance assessment for platted lots in subdivisions whose drainage systems will not be part of the regulated drain shall be set at \$35.00 per lot/minimum. Common areas within non-regulated drain subdivisions shall be assessed at \$5.00 per acre with a \$35.00 minimum.
- 6. Maintenance assessment for platted lots within subdivisions whose drainage system will be part of the regulated drain shall be set at \$65.00 per lot/minimum. Common areas within the regulated drain subdivisions shall be set at \$10.00 per acre with a \$65.00 minimum.

The total annual assessment for this drain will be \$7,873.78.

I recommend that the Board set a hearing for this name change for July 24, 2006.
