Comes now the petitioners, by their attorney David J. McMath, and it appearing to the court from the records of this case that the drainage commissioners on the first day of November 1904 filed their report in open court as provided by law, it now being more than ten days since the filing of said report, and no objection or remonstrance being filed thereto, the court now examines said report, and being sufficiently advised in the premises, now finds for the petitioners that the report of said drainage commissioners should in all things be confirmed and the assessments made thereby approved.

It is therefore considered ordered and adjudged by the court that the report of the drainage commissioners, made herein, to-wit:

The undersigned, Commissioners of Drainage, to whom was referred the petition of Elias Stuart and Charles Rawlings for the drainage of the lands therein described in said petition a certified copy of which is hereto attached being lands in Washington Township, Hamilton County, Indiana in Hamilton County, respectfully report that they have inspected personally all the lands described in said petition, and all other lands liable to be affected by the construction of the proposed work, and are of the opinion that the proposed

drainage will be practicable.

That when accomplished it will improve the public health, benefit the public highway running East and West thro  $N. \frac{1}{2}$  of Sec. 29 - Twp. 20 N. Range 3 East, and East and West road between Sections 29 & 32 and North and South road thro center of Sections 29 & 32 - Twp 20 - Range 3 East. And that said improvement will be of public utility and that the costs, damages and expenses of constructing said drainage will be less than the benefits to owners of lands likely to be benefitted thereby.

That the best and cheapest method by which said drainage can be accomplished is by a main ditch and two tributaries as described on page three of this report.

They estimate the cost of constructing the work - \$1209.<sup>95</sup>/<sub>100</sub> dollars. They further report that they have estimated the benefits and injury to the several -

Description of Location.

Main Ditch - Begin 818 ft. North and 283 ft. West of the S. E. Corner of the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 29 - Twp. 19 N. - Range 3 East and run thence S. 11° West 375 ft, thence S. 48° W. 325 ft. thence S. 30° W. 142 feet, thence S. 20° E. 1187 ft. thence S. 48° E. 587 ft. thence S. 284 ft. thence S. 35° E. 70- thence S. 48° E. 425 ft. thence S. 70° E. 200 ft. thence S. 85° E. 573 ft. thence N. 75° E. 170 ft. and terminating in an open drain 31 ft. South of the S. E. corner of the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 32 - Twp. 19 N. Range 3 East.

Ann #1 - Beginning 722 ft. South and 240 East - of the N. W. corner of the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 29

Typ. 1911. — Range 3 East and run thence S 20° E. 769 ft. and terminating in Main Ditch at Station 8+42.

Arm #1 To Arm #1 — Beginning 138 ft. North and 200 ft. West of the S. E. corner of the N. W. 1/4 of the S. W. 1/4 of Sec 29 — Typ. 1911. Range 3 East and run thence S. 62° East 909 and terminating in Arm #1 at Station 9+55.

#### Requirements

Said Main Ditch to consist of one row of 8" drain tile from station 0 to station 8+42 and one row of 15" drain tile from station 8+42 to station 18+50 and one row of 16" drain tile from station 18+50 to station 35+92 and one row of (sixteen) 16" sewer tile from station 35+92 to station 36 and an open drain one foot wide in bottom from station 36 to station 43+43. Arm #1 — to consist of one row of 8" drain tile from station 8 to station 9+55 and one row of 12" drain tile from station 9+55 to station 18+45 and to be connected to main ditch with a (Y) connection tile 15" X 12" X 8".

Arm #1 to Arm #1 — to consist of one row of 6" drain tile from station 0 to station 9+09 and to be connected to Arm #1 with (Y) connection tile 12" X 8" X 6".

At Station 36 on Main ditch to be constructed a stone retaining wall dimensions 15" X 5" X 2". Said wall to be built from field rocks or riggerheads and to be laid up in mortar made from one part Portland Cement to three parts good sharp sand and so constructed as to receive the tile at proper grade 18" above base of wall.

All dirt removed from open portion to be deposited not nearer than two feet from break or banks. All tile used in the

construction of said drain to be first class in every respect and to be laid in ditch on a true line at the proper grade with joints well matched and to be left uncovered until inspected and accepted by the Drainage Commissioner in charge of the work.

After being accepted the trench of ditch to be filled fall and where ditch runs in old open channel the tile to be covered to a depth of 24 inches.

All trees to be deadened for a distance of one rod on each side of ditch.

We have divided said drain in sections of 100 ft. in length numbering from 0 to 43+43 and the arms from the commencement to the terminus thereof. The number of cubic yds. on each of said stations and the depth of cut is shown as follows:

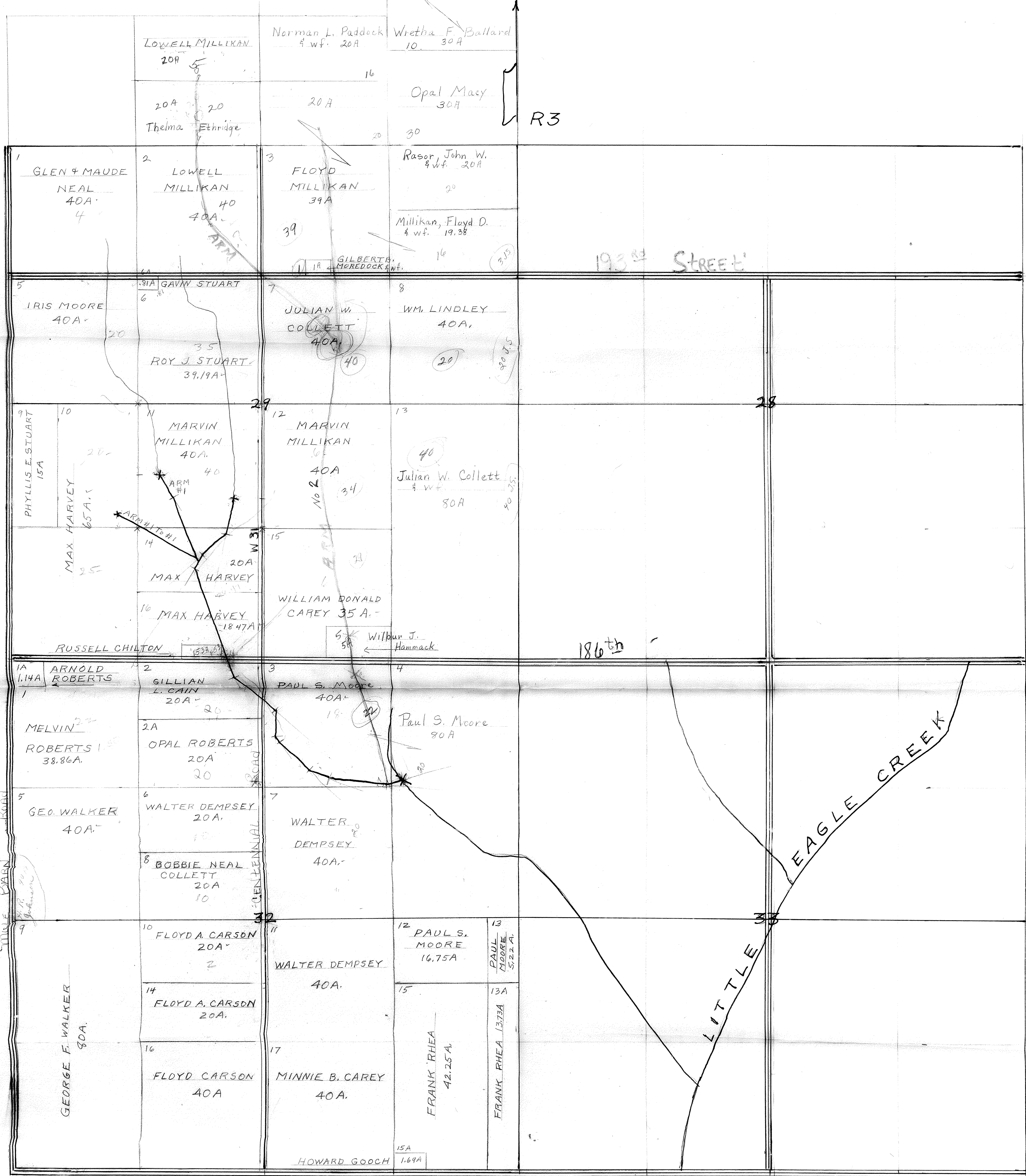

At Station 36 on Main Ditch to be constructed a Stone retaining Wall Dimensions 15'X 5'X2', Said wall to be built from field rocks or niggerheads and to be laid up in mortar made from one part Portland Cement to Three parts good sharp sand and so constructed as to receive the Tile at proper grade 18 inches above base of wall

All dirt removed from open portion to be deposited not nearer than Two feet from breaks of Banks , All Tile used in the construction of said Drain to be first class in every respect

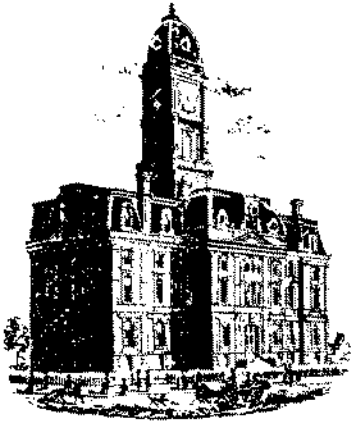

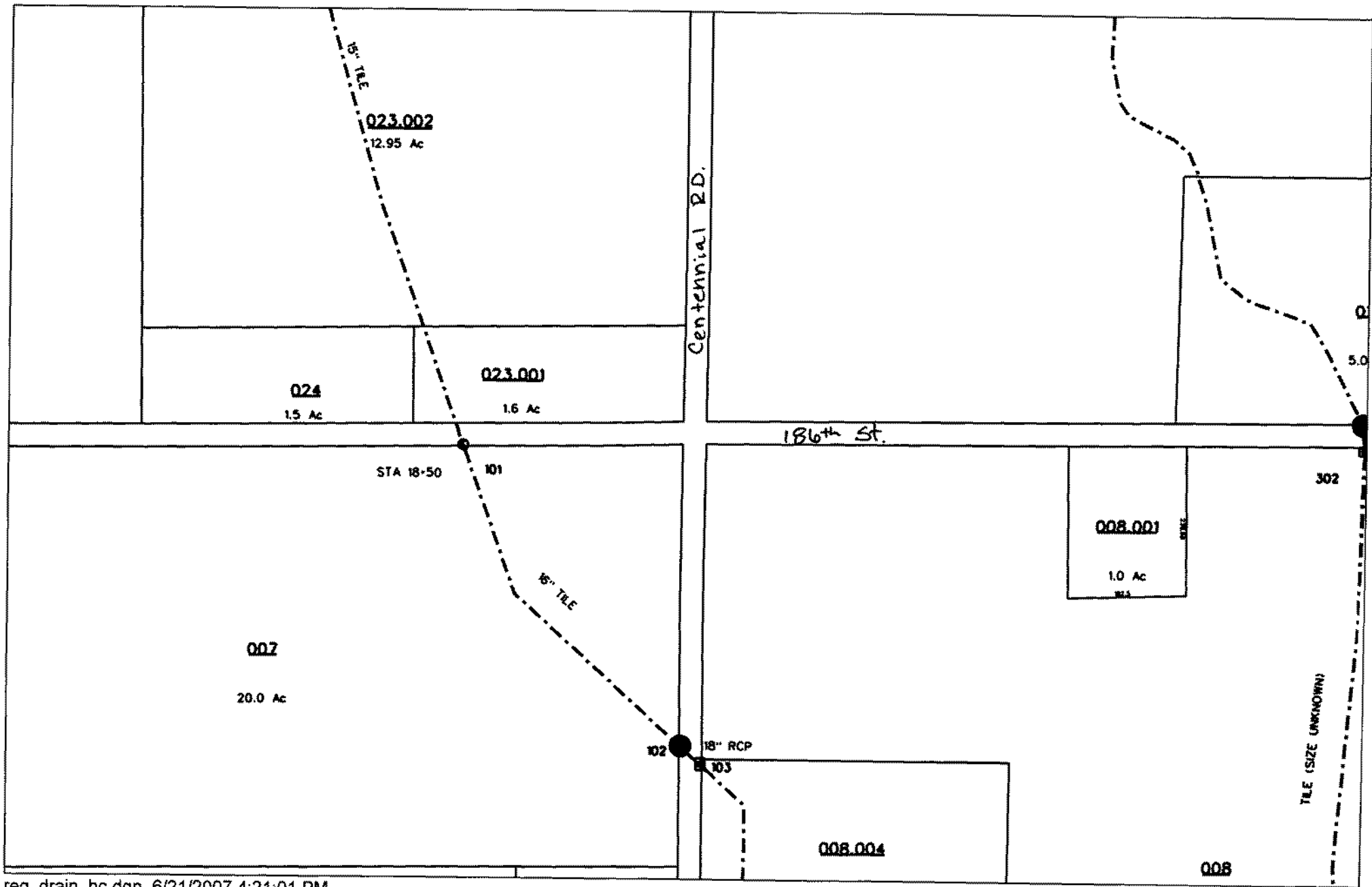
