Re: George Symonds Drain, R & S Corporation Extension

Attached is a drain map for the R & S Corporation Extension of the George Symonds Drain. This proposed drain is located in Adams Township.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described below. Upon doing so, I believe the drain is practicable, will improve the public health, benefit a public highway, be of public utility and that that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited.

This extension shall consist of approximately 750 feet of open drain beginning at the terminus of the George Symonds Drain at station 238+00, said terminus being approximately 200 feet south and 700 feet west of the center of Section 23, Township 20 North, and Range 3 east; thence following the existing open ditch in an easterly and northeasterly direction to the confluence with the terminus of the Ross & Mann Drain at station 63+00, said terminus being the north property line of parcel # 01-01-23-00-00-011.000.

The nature of maintenance work required is as follows:

- Bank erosion protection and/or seeding as might be required;
- Removal of debris and/or blockages from the drain;
- Removal of Beaver Dams;
- Any other repairs necessary to restore proper flow to the open ditch.

The frequency with which maintenance work should be performed is annually as required by the condition of the drain.


The easements for the drain should be set at 75 feet from top of bank as set out in IC 36-9-27-33. Additional drainage easement will be added to the following tracts:

According to the FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Map Number 18057C0025F, dated February 19, 2003 this area is covered by the floodplain. Therefore, I believe that no damages will result to landowners by the regulating of this drain.

I recommend that the Board set a hearing for this proposal for July 26, 2010.

FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the **George Symonds Drain, R & S Corporation Extension** came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing **on July 26, 2010**, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.


The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.


Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the **George Symonds Drain, R & S Corporation Extension** be and is hereby declared established.
