
I have inspected the drainage facilities for the Tamenend Drain and have found them to be complete and acceptable. The Project Engineer has submitted the Certificate of Completion and Compliance and "As Built" Drawings on reproducible mylar of the drainage system.

Upon review of the original report dated May 30, 1986, I found the portions of open ditch, which will be regulated drain are not very clear. To clarify this the following open ditch is to become regulated: Along Fall Creek Road in front of Lot 23 and running along the East side of the lot to the Reservoir; between Lots 6 and 7; between Lots 16 and 17; 15 and 16 and Tamenend Court, 13 and 14. Pipes included are the 12" CMP for the common drives for Lots 18, 19 and 20 off Brooks School Road; 18" CMP on Lot 14; 12" and 18" CMP on Lot 15, 24" CMP on Lot 17 and 12" CMP on Fall Creek Road for the common drive to Lots 21, 22 and 23. The existing 24" CMP under Fall Creek Road is not part of the regulated drain. The length of the drain remains at 1760 feet as noted on my original report.

At this time I recommend the Board approve the drainage facilities as constructed. I further recommend that the non-enforcement request for this plat be approved by the Board.

I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefitted. The drain will consist of the following:

12" CMP	290 feet	24" CMP	20 feet
15" CMP	20 feet	Open Ditch	1390 feet
18" CMP	40 feet		


The total length of the drain will be 1760 feet.

The drain to be maintained as a regulated drain will be the storm sewer between lots 6 and 7, along with the storm sewer in the intersection of Tamenend Court and Tamenend Trace. Other pipes and open ditch to be maintained are shown in RED shading on the attached development plan.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I

recommend a maintenance assessment of \$40.00 per lot and \$40.00 for roadways. With this assessment the total annual assessment for the drain/this section will be \$960.00.

I recommend a hearing be set for August 11, 1986. 9:15 am

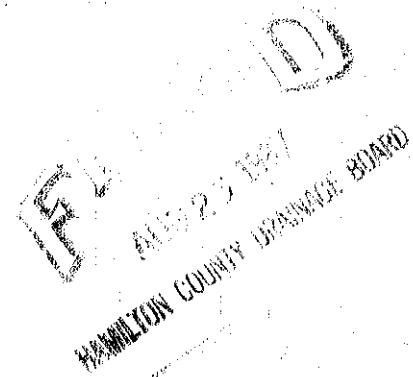

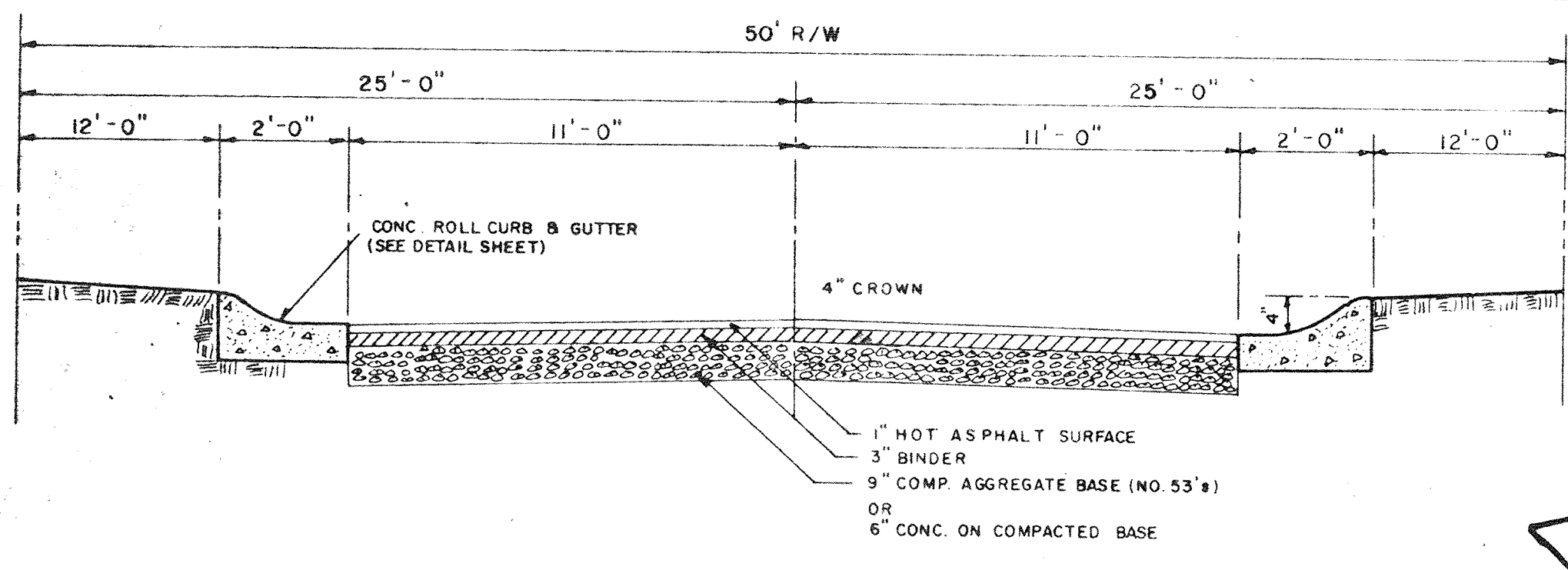

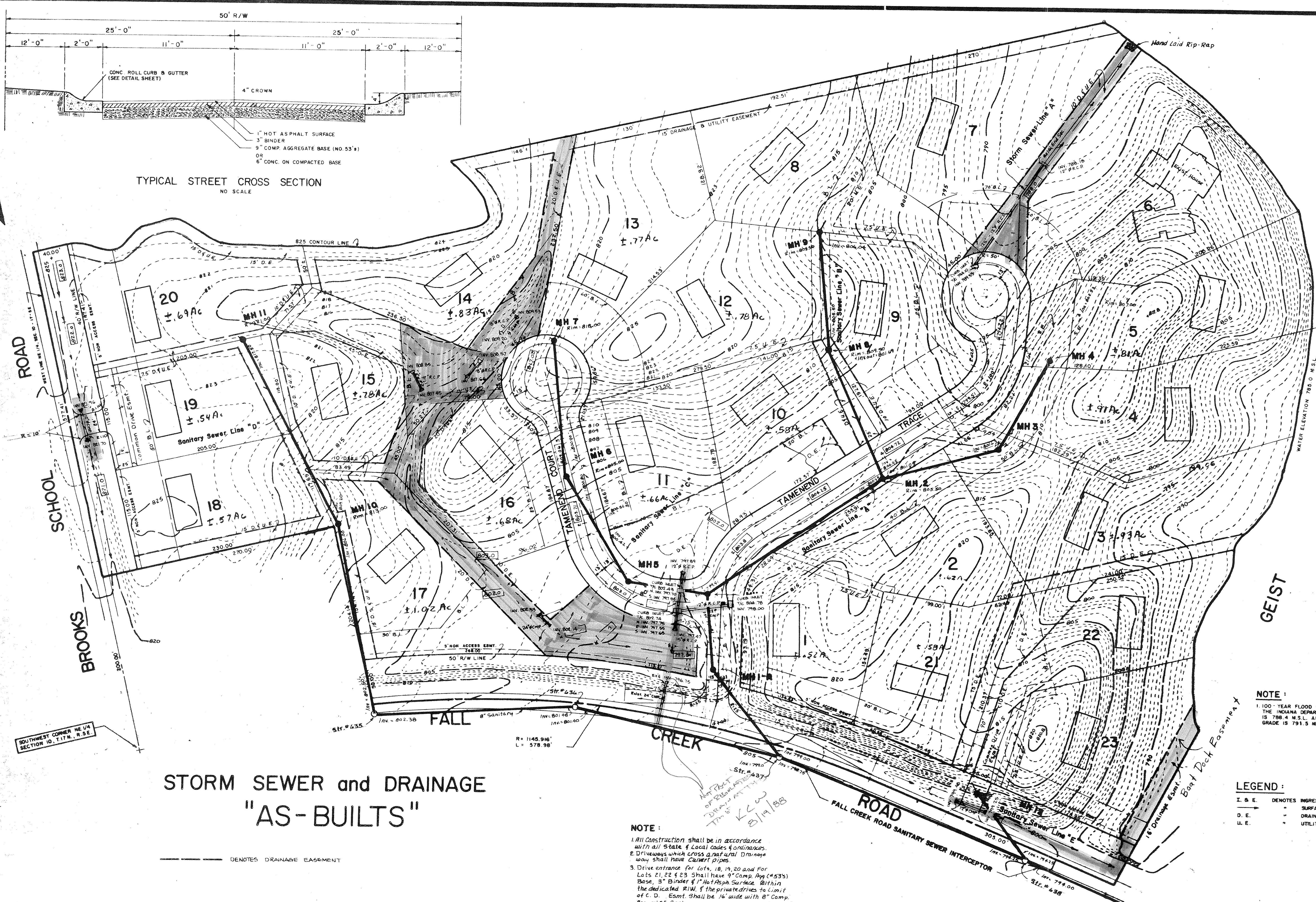

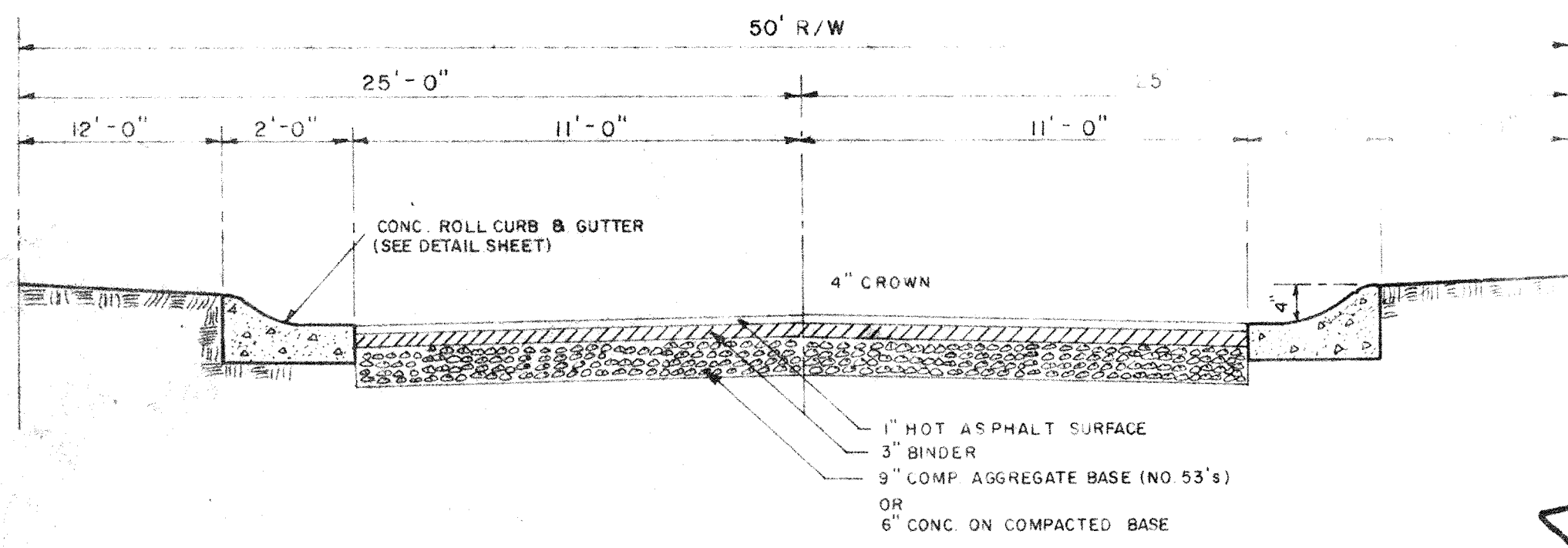

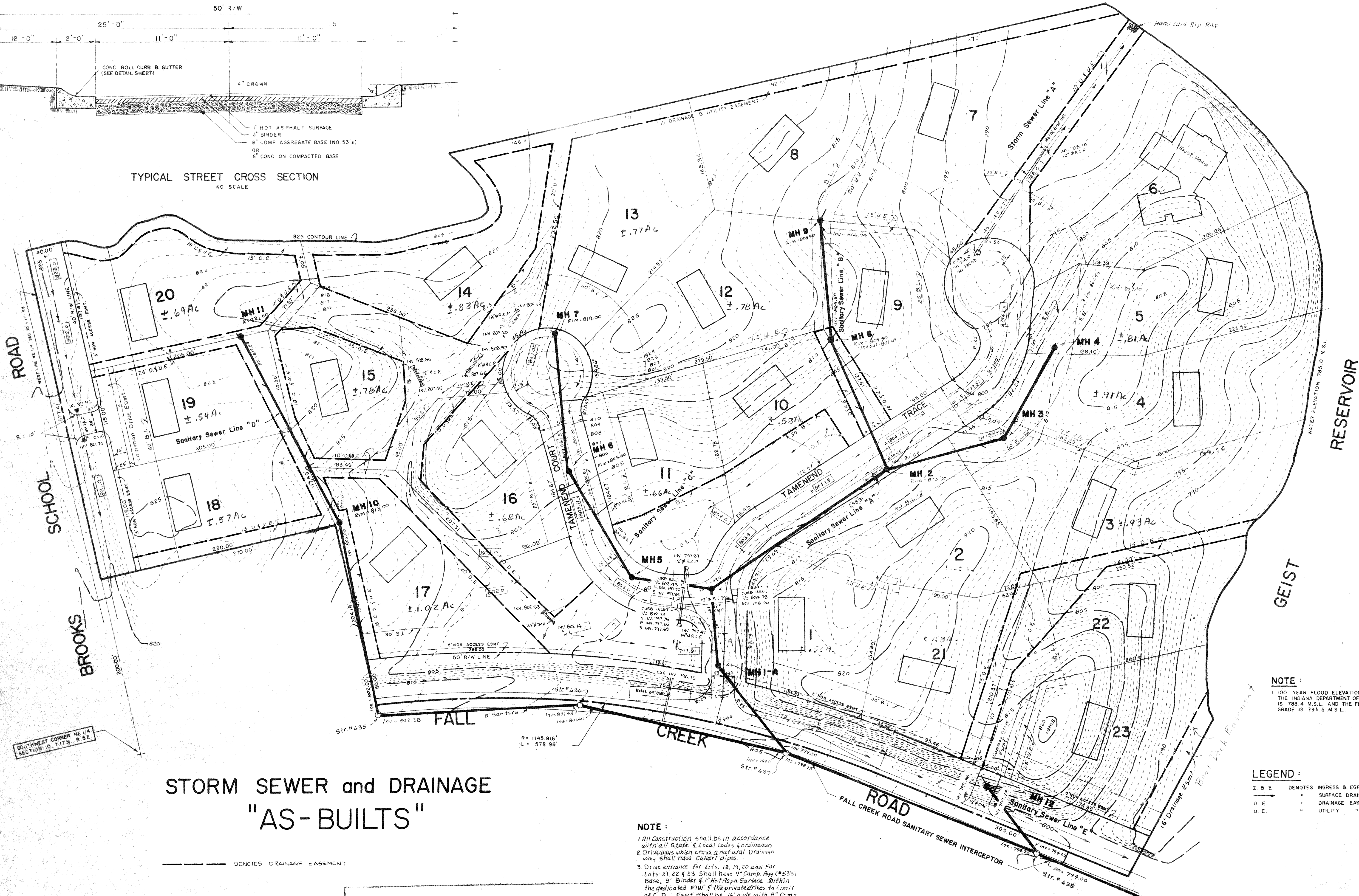
