Attached is a drain map, drainage shed map and Schedule of Assessments for the proposed extension of the N.H. Teter Drain. The proposed extension will begin at Sta. 49+50 of the drain and run to William Locke Drain. The Teter Drain was extended in 1980 from its original terminus of Sta. 45+50 to its current terminus of 49+50. (See reconstruction report dated August 29, 1980.) This proposal will add **1,850 feet** of open ditch to the drain.


Inspection of the drain found no serious problem with the open ditch. It is well maintained with good vegetation on the banks. The purpose of extending the drain is to ensure that the ditch is maintained. This will also connect the regulated drains to form continuity between the Teter and the Locke Drains.

At this time the drain is assessed at a rate of \$1.00 per acre, with a \$3.00 minimum. With 246 acres within the drainage shed, the annual collection for the drain is \$255.00. Currently the maintenance fund is at \$1,208.07. I recommend the \$3.00 minimum be changed to \$5.00 to meet State Code. I recommend the rate per acre remain at \$1.00 per acre.

Additional regulated drain easement will be placed on the following properties:

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposal for October 1998.
