Re: A. J. Brock Drain – Essex of Noblesville Section 1 Reconstruction

Attached is a 52.5 petition and plans for the proposed relocation of the A. J. Brock Drain. The relocation is being proposed by Essex on Hazel Dell LLC, Robert E. Anderson and Maureen K. Anderson Trust. The proposal is to reconstruct the drain across parcel 10-10-03-00-00-030.000, parcel 10-10-10-00-00-001.001, parcel 10-10-10-00-00-001.003, and parcel 10-10-10-00-00-001.000, as part of the Essex of Noblesville project per plans by Schneider Corp., Job No. 5575.001, latest revision date 8/7/2006. Per the plans, the drain will be routed through the Essex Subdivision from Hazel Dell Road on the west side of the project and discharge into the portion of the drain being reconstructed by the City of Noblesville as part of the Hazel Dell Road project at the east property line of the Essex Project. Until the new downstream storm sewer is installed, the site will discharge into the existing A. J. Brock Drain near the east property line via a proposed 18" storm sewer. After construction of the new line the existing Brock Drain east of the Essex project will be utilized for overflow for the 100-year storm event.

The portions to be regulated drain are those between the following Structures 608, 603, 676, 675, 662, 661 and 660. Also the section between 602 and 601 and the section between Structure 660 and the east property line of the Essex project. The remainder of the drainage facilities within the Essex Subdivision shall be the maintenance responsibility of the City of Noblesville.

This line will consist of the following:

18" RCP	23 ft.	36" RCP	338 ft.
30" RCP	64 ft.	Open Ditch	1,288 ft.

The total length of the new drain shall be 1,713 feet. The 1,273 feet of original drain between Sta. 11+95 and 14+00 of Arm 1 and between Sta. 26+00 and 36+68 of the main drain shall be removed. This proposal will add ^{*}44 feet to the drain's total length. On the main drain this is from the catch basin at approximately Sta. 26 to 601 as shown on the plans. On Arm 1 this is from the outlet to the pond to the catch basin at Sta. 26+00 of the main drain.

The cost of the relocation is to be paid by Essex on Hazel Dell, LLC. The developer has provided the Letter of Credit as follows:

Attached is a non-enforcement. The easement for the reconstructed drain will be per the secondary plat for Essex of Noblesville Section 1 as recorded in the Hamilton County Auditor's Office. I recommend that the Board approve this Non-enforcement request.

The open drain portion listed above is that area through the two detention ponds, Ponds 1 and 2. The detention ponds (Ponds 2 & 1) located in Common Areas C & E respectively are to be considered part of the regulated drain. Pond maintenance shall include the inlet, outlet, sediment removal and erosion control along the banks as part of the regulated drain. The maintenance of the ponds, such as mowing and aquatic vegetation control, will be the responsibility of the Homeowners Association. The Board will also retain jurisdiction for ensuring the storage volume for which the ponds were designed will be retained, thereby, allowing no fill or easement encroachments.

I recommend that this drain be classified as an urban drain. This drain may be assessed to the Vestal/Kirkendall Drainage Area in the future.

The project falls under the requirements as set out in IC 36-9-27-52.5. Therefore, a hearing is not required for the petition. I recommend that the Board approve this petition.



Re: Vestal-Kirkendall: AJ Brock - Essex of Noblesville Sec. 1 Relocation

Attached are plans, and other information for Essex of Noblesville Sec. 1 Relocation. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes were made to the drain, which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain-dated August 9, 2006. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held August 14, 2006. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 9, Pages 359-360) The changes are as follows: Structure 601 to 602 was not installed. This removed the 23 feet of 18" RCP from the proposed drain. The original AJ Brock 18" tile was capped at the property line of parcel 10-10-00-00-002.000 and a 6" PVC breather was set. Structure 608 to 603 was made twin 30" RCP with the Hazel Dell Rd. project. It should be noted that the original main AJ Brock Tile was removed from Sta. 24+12 to Sta. 36+68. Also removed was Arm 1 from Sta. 11+95 to Sta. 14+00. The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now **2051 feet.**


The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on September 25, 2006 and recorded under instrument #2011042489. The following sureties were guaranteed by Old National Bank and expired on August 14, 2007.

I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.




