MINUTES OF THE HAMILTON COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD
August 7, 1967

Mr. Calvin Hiatt, Chairman, called the Drainage Board to order at 1:30 PM on the 7th day of August, 1967, with the following members present; Mr. Floyd Carson and Mr. Roy Davis. also Mr. Allan Weihe, Hamilton County Surveyor present and Mr. Joe Roberts as the Board's Attorney. The following guests were present: Mr. Basil Kincaide, Mr. Lindemuth and Mr. Chas. Berry.

The minutes of the previous regular and special meetings were read and approved as read.

Mr. Basil Kincaide asked that the Anderson-Elanton Drain culvert across 104th Street ^{Anson} ^{Blant} be cleared and a new culvert replace the same. The Board decided to refer the request to the Highway Department.

Mr. Wilkes asked for help in cleaning and repairing of the Mary J. Johnson Drain, ^{Mary} Many open and tile. He had a report from the U.S. Engineering Department relative to Drains ^{Jewell} ^{OPA} as to the costs and requirements in the repair of same. It was agreed that Mr. Weihe is to send a letter recommending his idea as to what should be done and also the cost.

Mr. Chas. Berry, for Mrs. Hallie Berry Land, asked about the assessment on 20 acres ^{Marshall} ^{Davis} for the repair of the Martha Barrah Drain. He does not believe that the Martha Barrah Drain drains any of Mrs. Berry's land. It was shown to him by records and maps that the land has always been assessed for this drain. He accepted.

Mr. Lindemuth of the Indiana-Michigan Transmission Line asked the Board to check the location of the towers on a new transmission line across Hamilton County, Indiana, relative to interfering with the drainage system and Mr. Weihe, County Surveyor, is to check the data.

Mr. Weihe, as Hamilton County Surveyor, made a Maintenance Report for the Walker-Darnell Drain. This report is on file in the records of the Drainage Board.

A resolution was made, seconded and approved that the Walker-Darnell Drain as described be made a Legal Drain as petitioned and be classified as needing Annual Periodic Drainage Maintenance and the owners of land in the Drainage area for said Drain be assessed at the rate of 50¢ per acre per year and a minimum assessment of \$53 per year. A hearing is to be held on the 2nd day of October, 1967 at 2:00 P.M.

The Drainage Board secretary reports the following items: requests for legal drains be classified and/or repair that have been submitted since the last regular meeting:

The Drainage Board secretary reported that a letter was sent to the Clinton County Drainage Board asking for a definite date to start collecting assessments from the landowners on the Mathews Drain. A copy of the letter is on file.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting or a special called meeting.
