


Gasb 34 Footages for Historical Cost Drain Length Log

RE: Wheeler and Wheeler Drain #25

Attached is a petition for the extension of the Wheeler and Wheeler Drain. The proposed extension involves the existing open ditch from the current terminus of the Wheeler and Wheeler Drain, which is approximately at the West edge of Lot 7 in Fox Glen Subdivision. The extension will then follow the existing open drain West and North to its terminus in Stony Creek. This will consist of approximately 5500 feet of open ditch.

The open ditch is in fair condition, having no immediate maintenance needs. There are some areas where erosion has occurred. However, overall I believe those areas to be stable at this time.

Several tracts will have additional or new regulated drain across portions of the tract. Those affected are as follows:

At this time the drain is assessed at a rate of \$1.50 per acre, \$5.00 minimum. The current balance in the maintenance fund is \$6,521.52. This brings in an annual collection of \$1,337.28. Therefore, I recommend that the drains current assessment rate be left unchanged.
