Re: Wheeler and Wheeler Drain, Brighton Knoll Section 3 Arm

Attached is a petition and plans for the relocation of the Wheeler and Wheeler Drain through Brighton Knoll Section 3. This relocation was petitioned by Timberstone Development, LLC. The petition is to relocate the drain across the following parcels: parcel 10-11-17-00-14-080.000, owned by Brighton Knoll Community Association; parcel 10-11-17-00-20-001.000, owned by RH of Indiana LP; parcel 10-11-17-00-20-002.000, owned by RH of Indiana LP; parcel 10-11-17-00-20-003.000, owned by RH of Indiana LP; parcel 10-11-17-00-20-003.000, owned by Tyler Thompson and Torie A Bradburn; parcel 10-11-17-00-20-032.000, owned by RH of Indiana LP; parcel 10-11-17-00-20-033.000, owned by Irini S Guirges, Saad Guirges, Magda Botros and Christin Guirges; parcel 10-11-17-00-00-009.000, owned by RH of Indiana LP; and Atkinson Drive right-of-way owned by the City of Noblesville as part of the Brighton Knoll, Sec. 3 project per plans by Stoeppelwerth and Associates, Job No. 43400TRT-S3 dated 1/29/2010.

Per the plans, the Section 3 arm is located between Lake #3 and Str 707 (in Section 1). The affected structures for Section 3 arm include Strs. 775, 776, and 707. The plans also include the adjusted location of Ex. Str. 707 with 50' of pipe removed.

This line will consist of the following:

440' of 42" RCP

The total length of the new drain shall be 440 feet. The 579 feet of original drain between Sta. 9+84 and 15+63 shall be vacated. Sta. 15+63 was the upstream station previously vacated with Section 1 Relocation as recorded in Drainage Board minutes book 8, pages 449 – 451. This proposal will subtract 189 feet from the drain's total length. The relocation of Str. 707, noted above, removes 50' of pipe from the length stated in the final report for "Brighton Knoll, Sec. 1 Relocation" as recorded in Drainage Board minutes book 11, pages 355 – 356.

A Non-enforcement Request was previously approved by the Board on Oct 24, 2011 as noted in Drainage Board minutes book 14, pages 13 – 15, and recorded in the Hamilton County Recorders Office under Instrument No. 2012042906. The easement dimensions approved by the Board for the new drain will be per the Certificate of Plat Correction, as recorded in the Hamilton County Recorders office, under Instrument No. 2010046394.

The detention pond (Pond #3) at Sta. 9+84 is the subject of my report for "Wheeler and Wheeler Drain, Brighton Knoll Pond #3 Reconstruction" is to be before the Board for approval on December 19, 2012. Pond maintenance shall include inlet, outlet, sediment removal and erosion control along the banks as part of the regulated drain. The maintenance of the pond (lake) such as mowing and aquatic vegetation control will be the responsibility of the Homeowners Association. The Board will also retain jurisdiction for ensuring the storage volume for which the pond (lake) was designed will be retained, thereby, allowing no fill or easement encroachments.

I recommend that the Board set a hearing date for January 28, 2013.

On this  $28^{th}$  day of January, 2013, the Hamilton County Drainage Board has held a hearing on the Maintenance Report and Schedule of Assessments of the Wheeler & Wheeler Drain, Brighton Knoll Section 3 Arm, Station 9+84 to Station 15+63.

Evidence has been heard. Objections were presented and considered. The Board then adopted an order of action. The Board now finds that the costs of continued maintenance to the portion of the above drain exceed the benefits to the real estate benefited by the portion of the drain to be abandoned and issues this order vacating the above section of the Wheeler & Wheeler Drain, Brighton Knoll Section 3 Arm, Station 9+84 to Station 15+63.

## FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the Wheeler & Wheeler Drain, Brighton Knoll Section 3 Arm came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing on January 28, 2013, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the **Wheeler & Wheeler Drain**, **Brighton Knoll Section 3 Arm** be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:

Re: Wheeler & Wheeler Drain - Brighton Knoll Sec. 3 Arm

Attached are as-builts, certificate of completion & compliance, and other information for Brighton Knoll Section 3 Arm. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes were made to the drain, which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain-dated December 13, 2012. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held January 28, 2013. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 14, Pages 497-499) The changes are as follows:

The 42" RCP was shortened from 440 feet to 433 feet.

The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now 433 feet.

It should be noted that this project removed 36 feet of existing 42"RCP from the Brighton Knoll Section 1 Relocation. New Structure 707 was set 36 feet upstream on the existing 42" pipe. Old Structure 707, an end section, was removed along with the existing pipe.

Also removed was the existing JW Wheeler tile. The main tile was removed from Station 9+84 to Sta. 17+12. This station was the point at which the Brighton Knoll Section 1 Relocation had intercepted the tile. The original interception point was to be Sta. 15+63 but this changed to the actual field location of the tile and work done in the field.

The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on October 24<sup>th</sup> and recorded under instrument #2012042906. A surety was not received for this project.


I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.


