


REPORT OF HUGH JOHNSON, COUNTY SURVEYOR, HAMILTON COUNTY, INDIANA.

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF HAMILTON COUNTY, INDIANA.

The undersigned Surveyor of Hamilton County state of Indiana to whom was referred the above entitled petition for drainage at the Regular Session, August Term of the Commissioners Court, would respectfully report that as directed by the order given by the Auditor on August 1908 I made all necessary surveys and personal inspection of the lands named in the petition and all other lands likely to be affected by the proposed drain and that I would respectfully report as follows:-

That the drainage as proposed in said petition is practicable that the same when constructed will improve the public health, and will be of public utility, that said proposed drainage will benefit one public highway in Noblesville Township said County and State.

That the cost of construction and ~~1000.00~~ expenses of effecting said proposed drainage will be less than the benefits to the owners of lands assessed for the construction.

I would further respectfully represent and show to the Board that the proposed drain will not exceed two miles in length and will not cost to exceed Three Hundred Dollars exclusive of the tile that may be used therein, and that I am not interested in the said proposed drainage, and that I am not in any related to any of the parties likely to be affected thereby.

Location:-

Beginning at a point 25 feet S W of the N E corner of the N W  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17 Twp 18 Range 5 East and run thence N  $48^{\circ}$  E 165 Feet, thence N  $13^{\circ}$  W 245 feet, thence N  $55^{\circ}$  W 665 feet, thence N  $25^{\circ}$  W 592 feet terminating in what is known as the J W Wheeler Ditch at the line between Stoops and Wheeler.

Requirements.

Ditch to consist of one row of 12" drain tile from station 0 to station 16+ 57 and one row of 12" sewer tile from station 16 + 57 to station 16 + 67 or terminus, Said ditch to pass through and terminate at the stone wall to be built for the J W Wheeler et al, Ditch.

Deadening, Filling, Laying tile, etc.

All tile used in the construction of the ditch to be first class tile and subject to inspection of the Superintendent in charge of the work and to be laid in the ditch in a true line with joints well matched and at proper grade as shown on the profile hereto attached and marked EXHIBIT B and to be left uncovered until inspected by the Supt. after which they shall be covered with earth to a depth of 24 inches where the ditch runs in the old channel and where the ditch is new cut the trench shall be filled full and well tamped.

All trees to be deadened and bushes grubbed for a distance of 25 feet on each side of the ditch. All work to be done in a first class and workmanlike manner and to the full satisfaction of the Supt. in charge of the work.

Feet of 12 inch drain tile,----- 1657 feet.  
Feet of 12 inch sewer tile,----- 10 feet.

76/100 foot to each 100 feet from Sta. 0 to Sta. 16+67. or terminus.
