Attached is a petition, non-enforcement request, plans, calculations, quantity summary and assessment roll for the Section 4 Arm, Centennial Drain. I have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages, and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

Open	Ditch	100	ft	24"	RCP	707	ft
12"	RCP	311	ft	30"	RCP	272	ft
15"	RCP	807	ft	36"	RCP	674	ft

The total length of the drain will be 2,871 feet.

The subsurface drains (SSD) under curbs are not to be part of the regulated drain.

The open ditch listed above is that swale between Str. 601 and 601B

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I also believe that no damages will result to landowners by the construction of this drain. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$50.00 per lot, \$5.00 per acre for roadways, \$5.00 per acre for common areas, with a \$50.00 minimum. With this assessment the total annual assessment for this drain/this section will be \$3,713.46.

Parcels assessed for this drain may be assessed for the Osborn-Collins or Williams Creek Drains at sometime in the future.

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

I recommend that upon approval of the above proposed drain that the Board also approve the attached non-enforcement request. This request is for the reduction of the regulated drain easement to those widths as shown on the secondary plat for Centennial Section 4 as recorded in the office of the Hamilton County Recorder.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposed drain for December 26, 2000.

Petitioner is the owner of all lots in the land affected by the proposed new regulated drain. The drainage will affect various lots in Centennial , a subdivision in Hamilton County, Indiana. The general route of such drainage shall be in existing easements and along public roads as shown in the plans on file in the Surveyor's Office.

Petitioner believes that the cost, damages and expenses of the proposed improvement will he less than the benefits which will result to the owners of the land likely to be benefited thereby. Peterioner believes the proposed improvements will:

- 3. The Petitioner agrees to request in writing to the County Surveyor any changes from the approved plan and must receive written authorization from the County Surveyor prior to implementation of the change. All changes shall be documented and given to the Surveyor to be placed in the Drain File.
- 4. The Petitioner shall instruct his Engineer to provide a reproducable print on a 24" x 36" mylar of the final design of the Drainage System. This shall be submitted to the County Surveyor prior to the release of the Performance Bond.
- 5. The Petitioner shall comply with the Erosion Control Plan as as specified on the construction plans. Failure to comply with the Erosion Control Plan shall be determined by the Board as being an obstruction to the drainage system. The County Surveyor shall immediately install or repair the needed measures at Petitioners cost as per IC 36-9-27-46.

The Petitioner further requests that the Drain be classified as an Urban Drain.

Note: The sub-surface drain under the curb is no longer considered a part of the regulated drain. This decision was made in the Hamilton County Commissioners' meeting and recorded in the minutes for March 8, 1999

I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.


