Re: Williams Creek Drain - Centennial South Arm, Somerville Dr. & Ditch Road - Roundabout

Attached are petition, plans, and other information for the proposed reconstruction of the Williams Creek Drain – Centennial South Arm, for the Somerville Drive and Ditch Road Roundabout project. The reconstruction was petitioned by Estridge Development Management, LLC. Those changes are as follows:

Williams Creek Drain - Centennial South Arm: The project will set a new curb inlet structure, Str. #201, about 5 feet north of existing curb inlet #97 per the original Centennial South plans. From there will be 57 feet of 12" RCP to Str. #202, 46 feet of 12" RCP to Str. #202A, and 76 feet of 12" RCP to Str. 203. This is shown on Sheets C201 and C601 of the plans prepared by Innovative Engineering & Consulting, Inc., having job number 14109, and dated April 18, 2017.

The existing drain between new Str. #201 and existing structures 97, 96, and 95, which is 131 feet, will be removed. The road project will add 48 feet to the Williams Creek Drain, Centennial South Arra.

The cost of the reconstruction is to be paid by Estridge Development Management, LLC. There will be no charge in the current maintenance assessments.

Since the petitioner is working under agreement with the City of Westfield and within the City of Westfield ROW, no bond is required for the relocation/reconstruction work.

The parcels affected by this project are as follows:

Parcel	Owner
Somerville Drive ROW	City of Westfield
Ditch Road ROW	City of Westfield

No changes are being made to the easements for the Centennial South Regulated Drains as shown on the secondary plat for Centennial South as recorded in the office of the Hamilton County Recorder.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposed reconstruction for a date to be determined by the Board.

On this  $22^{nd}$  day of January, 2018, the Hamilton County Drainage Board has held a hearing on the Maintenance Report and Schedule of Assessments of the Williams Creek Drain, Centennial South Arm, Somerville Dr. & Ditch Road Roundabout (New Structure 201 and Existing Structures 97, 96 and 95).

Evidence has been heard. Objections were presented and considered. The Board then adopted an order of action. The Board now finds that the costs of continued maintenance to the portion of the above drain exceed the benefits to the real estate benefited by the portion of the drain to be abandoned and issues this order vacating the above section of the Williams Creek Drain, Centennial South Arm, Somerville Dr. & Ditch Road Roundabout (New Structure 201 and Existing Structures 97, 96 and 95).

## FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the Williams Creek Drain, Centennial South Arm, Somerville Dr. & Ditch Road Roundabout came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing on January 22, 2018, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the Williams Creek Drain, Centennial South Arm, Somerville Dr. & Ditch Road Roundabout be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:

Re: Williams Creek: Centennial South Arm - Sommerville Rd & Ditch Rd Roundabout

Attached are as-built, certificate of completion & compliance, and other information for the Sommerville Rd & Ditch Rd Roundabout. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes were made to the drain, which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain-dated November 3, 2017. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held January 22, 2018. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 18, Pages 16-18) The changes are as follows: the 12" RCP was shortened from 179 feet to 170 feet. The length of the drain due to the changes described above is now **170 feet**. The road improvements removed 132 of existing 12" RCP installed with Centennial South.

The work for this project was done within existing drainage easement and road right of way. The project was paid for by Estridge Development Management, LLC. This work was done based upon an agreement with the City of Westfield, therefore no sureties were obtained.


I recommend the Board approve the drain's construction as complete and acceptable.
