Re: John Osborn Drain, Crooked Stick Estates Section 7 Extension

Attached is a drain map for the John Osborn Drain, Crooked Stick Estates Section 7 Extension. This proposed drain is located in Clay Township.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described below. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable, will improve the public health, benefit a highway and be of public utility and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

Open Ditch – 1,606 feet

The John Osborn Drain, Crooked Stick Estates Section 7 Extension shall begin at the west property line of parcel 17-13-04-03-04-018.000, owned by 1800 106<sup>th</sup> Street Partners, LLC, and run downstream within the existing Well Run channel 1,606 feet to the confluence with Spring Mill Run on parcel 17-13-04-00-00-086.000, owned by Crooked Stick Golf Club, Inc. The confluence with Spring Mill Run is approximately 220 feet north of the center line of 106<sup>th</sup> Street and 2,421 feet east of the center line of Towne Road.

The nature of maintenance work required is as follows:

- 1. Bank erosion protection and/or seeding as might be required;
- 2. Removal of debris and/or blockages from existing open drain;
- 3. Removal of beaver dams;
- 4. Any other repairs necessary to restore proper flow to the open ditch.

The frequency with which maintenance work should be performed is annually as required by the condition of the drain.

The easement for the drain on the parcels should be set at 50' from the top of bank as set out in IC 36-9-27-33 for Tract 17-13-04-03-04-018.000 and 17-13-04-00-00-086.000. The easement for the regulated drain across Lots 110, 111 and 112 of Crooked Stick Estates, Section 7 shall be those platted drainage easements per the plat for Crooked Stick Estates, Section 7, as recorded in the office of the Hamilton County Recorder (PB 8, Pages 117 to 119). According to the FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Map, Map Number 18057C0205F, the area for the John Osborn, Crooked Stick Estate Section 7 Extension is covered by the floodplain for Well Run. Therefore, I believe that no damages will result to landowners by the regulating of this drain.

### FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the John Osborne Drain, Crooked Stick Estates Section 7 Extension came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing on May 24, 2010, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the John Osborne Drain, Crooked Stick Estates Section 7 Extension be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:
