

I have inspected the drainage facilities for the Autumn Wood Farms Arm of the O.F. Henley Drain and have found them to be complete and acceptable. Engineer has submitted the Certificate of Completion and Compliance and "As Built" Drawings on reproduceable mylar of the drainage system.

Only one slight change was made during the construction of the drain. located at the point the twelve (12") inch concrete tile from the North turned East and ran along the North side of 146th Street was omitted. This was done because the line is approximately twenty (20') feet North of the Right of Way and twenty (20') feet East of the North South fence. Because of that the riser would have been in the way of the flarm operation.

The drain as constructed consists of the following approximate lengths:

2340 feet

12" Concrete Tile

5370 feet

12" RCP

360 feet

25 feet




