Attached is a petition, plans, non-enforcement request, calculations, quantity summary and assessment roll for the Section 4, Park Meadows Arm, The Parks @ Springmill Drain. have reviewed the submittals and petition and have found each to be in proper form.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described in the petition. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable; will improve the public health; benefit a public highway and be of public utility; and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

12"	RCD	383	feet	30"	RCP	190	feet
15"	RCP	466	feet	33"	RCP	76	feet
18"	RCP	681	feet	36"	RCP	148	feet

The total length of the drain will be 2,137 feet.

The subsurface drains (SSD) to be part of the regulated are those located under the curbs. Only the main SSD lines which are located within the Right-of Way are to be maintained as regulated of the drain. The portion of the SSD which will be regulated other than those under curbs are as follows: Rear Lots 81, 97 to 102, 85 to 96.

I have reviewed the plans and believe the drain will benefit each lot equally. Therefore, I recommend each lot be assessed equally. I also believe no damages will result to landowners by

the construction of this drain. I recommend a maintenance assessment of \$35.00 per lot, \$5.00 per acre for roadways, with a \$35.00 minimum. With this assessment the total annual assessment for this drain/this section will be \$ 1.6.59 14.

Parcels assessed for this drain shall be assessed for the Collins-Osborn Drain or Williams Creek Drain at sometime in the future.

I believe this proposed drain meets the requirements for Urban Drain Classification as set out in IC 36-9-27-67 to 69. Therefore, this drain shall be designated as an Urban Drain.

I recommend that upon approval of the above proposed drain that the Board also approve the attached non-enforcement request. This request is for the reduction of the regulated drain easement to those easement widths as shown on the secondary plat for The Parks @ Springmill Drain, Section 4, Park Meadows as recorded in the office of the Hamilton County Recorder.

I recommend the Board set a hearing for this proposed drain for July 1997.




