Re: Williams Creek Drain, Williams Creek Farms Arm

Attached is a drain map for the extension of the Williams Creek Drain. This proposed drain is located in Clay Township.

I have made a personal inspection of the land described below. Upon doing so, I believe that the drain is practicable, will improve the public health, benefit a highway and be of public utility and that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed drain will probably be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of land likely to be benefited. The drain will consist of the following:

Open Ditch - 1,857 feet

The drain shall begin at the north property line of parcel 17-09-35-01-01-001.000, owned by Karl & Cheryl Koch and run downstream within the existing Williams Creek channel 1,857 feet to the west right of way of Springmill Road.

The easement for the drain shall be the existing drain, & utility easement as shown on the secondary plat for Williams Creek Farms, as recorded in the Office of the Hamilton County Recorder in Plat Book 8, Pages 1 thru 3. According to the FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Maps, Map Number 18057C0206F and 18057C0208F, this area is also covered by the floodplain for Williams Creek. Therefore, I believe that no damages will result to landowners by the regulating of this drain.

FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the Williams Creek Drain, Williams Creek Farms Arm came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing on June 28, 2010, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the Williams Creek Drain, Williams Creek Farms Arm be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:
