RE: Wilson & Nagle Drainage Area

Attached is an assessment roll, drain map and drainage shed map for the Wilson & Nagle Drainage Area. This drainage system consists of the Martz and Treitch, Wm Wilson, Wm Nagle and Guy Booth Drains. These drains are located in Sections 13,14 23 and 24, Township 20 North, Range 4 East in Jackson Township and within the Town of Arcadia.

The Wm Wilson Drain was originally the Isaac Martz & Peter Trietch. This drain was constructed in 1882 by order of the Circuit Court. It consisted of a main ditch 6700 feet in lenght and a arm 540 feet for a total of 7240 feet of open drain. In 1894 the Wm Wilson Drain was ordered constructed by the Commissioners. This consisted of placing tile in 5410 feet of the old Martz and Trietch Main Open Ditch.

The Wm Nagle Drain was originally constructed in 1882 by order of the Circuit Court. This drain was 4477 feet of main ditch, Arm #1 was 719 feet and Arm #2 was 391 feet for a total lenght of 5587 feet. In 1892 the Commissioners ordered constructed a second Wm Nagle Drain. This consisted of a main ditch 3000 feet which duplicated Arm #2 of the original Nagle and a part of the Martz & Treitch Drain. Arm #1 was a duplication and extention of the original Main Nagle Drain and was 3813 feet in lenght. Arm #2 was the same as the original Nagle Arm #2 and was 391 feet in lenght. This drain then consisted of 7204 feet.

In 1921 the Guy Booth Drain was ordered constructed by the Circuit Court. This drain extended, tiled and retiled the Wm Nagle and Wm Wilson Drains. This drain also rerouted a portion of the Nagle Drain. In doing so 600 feet of the 1892 Nagle Drain was rerouted from STA 13\$00 to STA 19+00 of the main This copy printed from the Digital Archive of the Hamilton County Surveyor's Office; One Hamilton Co. Square, Ste. 188, Noblesville, In 46060 feet and the extention was 1118 feet

for a total of 2083 feet of new, non duplicated drain.

For simplicity's sake when the Nagle Drain is discussed is shall be the 1892 drain. The Wilson shall be both the Martz & Trietch and Wilson. THE Booth shall be that portion which did not duplicate either the Wilson or Nagle

A fifth drain known as the Jacob Gettle was found not to exist. It was dismissed in Circuit Court in November 1891 and never constructed.

The last assessment and repair by the county on these drains was in 1951. However, the Town of Arcadia has done repair and some rerouting on its own. In 1966 the Town rerouted two portions of the drains without cutting off the old portion which are still in operation. This was done to relieve the under capicity of the old drain. One rerouting started at STA 20 of the Booth and ended at STA 34+10 of the Booth. This consisted of 1587 feet of new storm sewer. The other location started at STA 11+50 of the Wm Wilson to STA 0 of the Booth Drain. This consists of 1253 feet of new storm sewer. These storm sewer improvements are shown on plans by Stoeppelwerth & Assoc. dated August 29, 1966.

At present the drainage system consists of the following:

William Wilson Drain 7240 feet
William Nagle Drain 6304 feet
Guy Booth Drain 2083 feet
TOTAL 15,627 feet

Upon inspection the above named drains seem to be in good condition.

My/recommendation to the Drainage Board is as follows:

- Vacate Arm #1 of the Martz & Treitch Drain, 540 feet
  - Extend the Booth Drain from the Headwall at STA 34+10 to the East Right of Way line of State Road 19, 506 feet
  - 3. Accept the storm sewer system installed by the Town of Aracdia as part of the Booth Drain as discussed above. Arm #2 would be an extention from STA 11+50 of the Wilson to STA 0 of the Booth and Arm #3 would be an extention from STA 20 to STA 34+10 of the Booth Drain. The existing tile from STA 30 of the Nagle to 34+10 of the Booth should remain a part of the drain system for overflow purposes. This would add 2840 feet to the Booth Drain.
  - 4. Place the Wilson and Nagle Drainage area on a maintenance program. With 669.3046 acres and 55‡ Lots in the drainage shed at \$2.00 per acre, \$6.00 minimum assessment will generate \$517₹.40 annually. This had been requested on March 28, 1968 by Wayne Noel-Town Trustee for the Nagle and on March 24, 1969 by the Town of Arcadia by Russell Whisler on both the Nagle and Wilson Drains.
  - 5. A hearing for the above should be set for April 4, 1983 at 1:35pm

Upon completion of the above recommendations the total lenght of the drains will be increased to 18,433 feet.
