RE: Wilson and Nagle Drainage Area

On February 28, 1983 a petition was filed by residence of Day'Acres in Arcadia to include an existing 8" tile drain as part of the William Wilson Drain.

This tile begins at a catch basin on the West side of Countryside Drive and enters the Wilson Drain in the catch basin at STA 0+00. An approximate description is as follows: Begining at a point 500 feet North and 230 feet West of the SouthEast corner of Section 14, Township 20 North Range 4 East, thence running SouthEast 400 feet to STA 0 of the William Wilson Drain.

I have inspected the drain and found it to be operational. The two catch basins, one on both sides of Countryside Drive, need repair. I estimate \$400000 to do this needed repair.

I recommend that the Board accept this report as an amendemnt to the report submitted on February 7, 1983. I further suggest that this tile be considered as Arm #1 of the William WIlson Drain. This would change the total footage of the drainage area to $\frac{18,833}{16}$ $\frac{16}{227}$ $\frac{227}{16}$
