We George Cornelius  
William Newby and Frederick Ginter  
the appraisers appointed by the  
Board of Commissioners of Hamilton  
County Indiana to assess the  
amount of benefits or injuries to  
the lands liable to be affected  
by the construction of a proposed  
Ditch petitioned for by Wm Hammond  
and Jno. S. Craig said Ditch  
commencing at the North East corner  
of Section No 33 Tp 19 Range 5 East  
and running in a South Westely  
direction and ending 633 feet south  
of the North West quarter of the South  
West quarter of the North East quarter  
of Section 32 Tp 19 Range 5

And also an arm or branch  
beginning at stake 80 on the main  
Ditch on the land of J. B. Carey  
that is the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section  
32 Tp 19 Range 5 East running in a  
North east direction to the line of Jno  
S. Craig from stake 80 to 4 x 40 feet  
on the land of Jno. S. Craig North  
1/2 of the NW 1/4 Sec 32 Tp 19 R 5  
from stake 4 x 40 ft to 18 x 85 feet  
to the line of Jno. S. Craig  
to the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4

We direct that said Ditch commence at Stake 46 on the line between Wm Hammond and Anthony Hamble, said Ditch to be constructed as set forth in the survey with the following exceptions

That the Petitioner may construct an 8<sup>in</sup> Tile Ditch from the commencement of said ditch at Stake No 46 through the cleared land on the land of Anthony Hamble and Wm Hammond ending at Stake 10 at his own Expense

also that John S Craig shall keep the Tile Ditch in the arm or branch in repair its entire length

We also assess Benefits to the public highway in Noblesville township to be paid by the Taster of said township amount \$10,00
