Re: Elwood Wilson Drain, W. Hare & Son Arm

Attached is a petition and plans for the proposed relocation of the Elwood Wilson Drain. The relocation is being proposed by Kahlo Limited Partnership IV. The proposal is to relocate the existing W. Hare & Son Arm tile across parcels 11-11-05-00-00-011.001, 11-11-05-00-00-011.002, and 11-11-05-00-00-011.003. This relocation is being done as part of the Kahlo Jeep project per plans by Stoeppelwerth and Associates, Job Number 47300, approved June 14, 2005.

This line will consist of the following:

10" PVC 1,247 ft.

Open Swale 1,321 ft.

The 1,321 feet of open swale parallels the 1,267 feet of proposed 10" pipe and 54 feet of the existing tile.

The total length of new tile shall be 1,267 feet. The 1,600 feet of original drain between Sta. 35+10 and Sta. 51+10 shall be vacated. This proposal will subtract 333 feet from the drains total length.

The cost of the relocation is to be paid by Kahlo Limited Partnership IV. Because the project is to be paid by the petitioner and is within the boundaries of the petitioner's property, the project falls under the requirements as set out in IC 36-9-27-52.5. Therefore, a hearing is not required for the petition.

The petitioner has provided the Performance Bond as follows:

Re: Elwood Wilson Drain: Kahlo Relocation of the W. Hare & Son Arm

Attached are as-builts, certificate of completion & compliance, and other information for Kahlo Relocation of the W. Hare & Son Arm. An inspection of the drainage facilities for this section has been made and the facilities were found to be complete and acceptable.

During construction, changes were made to the drain, which will alter the plans submitted with my report for this drain-dated December 9, 2005. The report was approved by the Board at the hearing held December 22, 2005. (See Drainage Board Minutes Book 8, Pages 572-573) The changes are as follows:

The 10" PVC was shortened from 1267 to 1264 feet. The open swale remained at 1321 feet. The 10" PVC tile and the open swale run parallel to one another. Therefore, the length of the drain due to the changes described above is now **1321 feet**. It should be noted that the original W. Hare & Son tile was removed from Sta. 35+10 to Sta. 51+10. Subsequently, 279 feet of drain was removed from the watershed's overall length.

The non-enforcement was approved by the Board at its meeting on December 22, 2005and recorded under instrument #200600004927.

The following sureties were guaranteed by Fifth Third Bank and expired on July 5, 2006.


