Re: Cool Creek Drain - Anna Kendall Arm - Grand Junction Plaza - Grassy Branch Creek Phase 2 Reconstruction

Attached is a petition and plans for the proposed reconstruction of the Anna Kendall Arm of the Cool Creek Drain. The reconstruction is being proposed by the City of Westfield. The proposal is to reconstruct the existing open ditch and relocate a portion of the original open ditch, to better facilitate the development of Grand Junction Plaza.

This line will consist of the following:

541 feet of Open Ditch

The total length of the new open drain shall be 541 feet. The 551 feet of the original drain between Sta. 174+73 and Sta. 180+24 per the original 1882 legal description, shall be vacated. This proposal will remove a total of 10 feet from the Anna Kendall Arm of the Cool Creek Drain's total length.

The open ditch listed above is from the downstream end of the Cool Creek Drain, Anna Kendall Arm, Mill Street Reconstruction per my report dated September 29, 2015, with hearing date of November 23, 2015 (See DB Minutes Book 16, pages 355 to 359) to the west ROW line of South Union Street. This is as shown on pages NR-2.1, NR-2.2, and NR-3.0 of the plans for Grand Junction Plaza – Grassy Branch Creek Phase 2, by Williams Creek Consulting, with job number 01.1270, and dated September, 2017.

The cost of the relocation is to be paid by the City of Westfield.

The City of Westfield is responsibility for any and all state and federal level permits associated with this project. At this time the permits are in the process but I am not aware that final permit approval has been granted.

Since the petitioner is the City of Westfield and is being performed under public bid process, no bond is required for the relocation/reconstruction work.

The reconstruction will be located on or affect the regulated drain easement on the following parcels:

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FINDINGS AND ORDER

CONCERNING THE PARTIAL VACATION OF THE

Station 174+73 to Station 180+24 from the Original Anna Kendall Arm of the Cool Creek Drain

On this 22^{nd} day of January, 2018, the Hamilton County Drainage Board has held a hearing on the Maintenance Report and Schedule of Assessments of the Cool Creek Drain, Anna Kendall Arm, Grand Junction Plaza, Grassy Branch Creek Phase 2 Reconstruction (Station 174+73 to Station 180+24 from the Original Anna Kendall Arm of the Cool Creek Drain).

Evidence has been heard. Objections were presented and considered. The Board then adopted an order of action. The Board now finds that the costs of continued maintenance to the portion of the above drain exceed the benefits to the real estate benefited by the portion of the drain to be abandoned and issues this order vacating the above section of the Cool Creek Drain, Anna Kendall Arm, Grand Junction Plaza, Grassy Branch Creek Phase 2 Reconstruction (Station 174+73 to Station 180+24 from the Original Anna Kendall Arm of the Cool Creek Drain).

FINDINGS AND ORDER FOR RECONSTRUCTION

The matter of the proposed Reconstruction of the Cool Creek Drain, Anna Kendall Arm, Grand Junction Plaza, Grassy Branch Creek Phase 2 Reconstruction came before the Hamilton County Drainage Board for hearing on January 22, 2018, on the Reconstruction Report consisting of the report and the Schedule of Damages and Assessments. The Board also received and considered the written objection of an owner of certain lands affected by the proposed Reconstruction, said owner being:

Evidence was heard on the Reconstruction Report and on the aforementioned objections.

The Board, having considered the evidence and objections, and, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did find and determine that the costs, damages and expenses of the proposed Reconstruction will be less than the benefits accruing to the owners of all land benefited by the Reconstruction.

The Board having considered the evidence and objections, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, did adopt the Schedule of Assessments as proposed, subject to amendment after inspection of the subject drain as it relates to the lands of any owners which may have been erroneously included or omitted from the Schedule of Assessments.

The Board further finds that it has jurisdiction of these proceedings and that all required notices have been duly given or published as required by law.

Wherefore, it is ORDERED, that the proposed Reconstruction of the Cool Creek Drain, Anna Kendall Arm, Grand Junction Plaza, Grassy Branch Creek Phase 2 Reconstruction be and is hereby declared established.

Thereafter, the Board made inspection for the purpose of determining whether or not the lands of any owners had been erroneously included or excluded from the Schedule of Assessments. The Board finds on the basis of the reports and findings at this hearing as follows:
